NEWS IN BRIEF

Nixon okays deathly air

DESPITE THE FACT that President Nixon signed the Environmental Policy Act two and one-half-years ago with the declaration that it is "now or never," heavy pressures from major industries affected by the anti-pollution law has caused some telling backtracking. It seems that the administration didn't mean to make it the effective weapon that it has become by vent of a recent court decision. Current moves to water down the measure clearly demonstrates the administration's callous disregard for the health and well-being of US citizens when it conflicts with mindless profiteering: Many deathly ills have been linked to pollution, and a recent Howard University study has attributed an alarming rise in cancer deaths among Blacks to harmful carcinogens being pumped into the air.

NAACP blasts Nixon Court

THE NAACP has recently declared "war" upon the Nixon administration's blatant usurpation of the high court, expressly prohibited by the US constitution. Speaking at the organization's 63rd Annual Convention at Detroit, the Rev. Stephen G. Spottswood exposed the farce of the court's supposed "objectivity." The keynote speaker declared, "There are inescapable signs that the Supreme Court is being successfully remade in the image of the President." Then warning of the threat to civil rights, he pointed out: "If the courts can be stopped from enforcing the constitution in education, they can be stopped in housing, employment, public accommodations and the administration of justice.

King Hussein has just celebrated the grand opening of a satellite station built and financed by the U.S. and British governments. U.S. Undersecretary of State, Joseph Sisco, described the occasion as an important event with hope that the station will bring a better understanding of the United States

THE PUBLICIZED purpose of this station is to modernize the means of communication. However, the size and expense of the station suggest that it has another purpose. The true purpose becomes clear when one knows that this station can cover the entire Middle East, the Mediterranean and the Red Sea states

What is the function of this station? A report published by the Palestinian Resistance Movement stated that this station will play the same role the U.S. played by Intelligenceship Liberty. The guerrilla report sheds light on the following points:

company which supervised the construction of this costly and non - profitable project is an official institution which belongs to the U.S. government. This company is responsible for all U.S. satellite stations covering wide areas of the globe. These stations designed to gather intelligence information which is considered vital for U.S. strategic interest.

This station built in Jordan will have the capability of monitoring all messages between Arab capitals and embassies between one capital and another capital and between any Arab army and its units. Futhermore, this station can monitor all messages sent by the Soviet fleet in the Mediterranean and Red Seas, and record photos sent by U.S. intelligence satellites circling the earth.

In addition to this, the U.S. has increased the Jordanian war capabilities. In the words of the commander of the

Jordanian armed forces, Zaid Ibu Shaker (Hussein's cousin) the Jordanian army has a total strength of seven Arab armies.

Upon consultation with the Israeli government, the United States supplied Jordan with a great number of M - 60 tanks and long range artillery. Hussein has no intention to liberate the West Bank of Jordan taken by Israel. His ultimate goal is to topple the governments of Iraq and Syria and protect the colonial interests of the United States: number The Arabs' enemy.

McGovern warms up to South Africa, Israel

WASHINGTON, D.C. - It took more than 15 months of political unity conferences, a series of Congressional Caucus hearings, a National Black Political convention in Gary, Indiana, and the issurance of a National Black agenda to establish a semblance of unified Black strategy prior to the upcoming Democratic and Republican conventions.

BUT IT TOOK less than 15 minutes at a press conference called by three Black politicans and Democratic candidate George McGovern to explode the myth of the Black political strategy, and set off charges of "betrayal" and "deceit" among the proponents of collective Black

The scene was typical of past performances for the Black politicians: Grinning, in clasped - hand embrace with their white political frontrunner, Black Congressmen Walter Fauntroy (Del - D.C.), William Clay (D-Mo.) and Louis Stokes (D-Ohio) dramatically announced

Nixon's court: A task force against freedom

NEW YORK (LNS) - In two recent decisions, the Nixon appointees to the Supreme Court, with the help of Justices White and Stewart, have ruled against anti war leafletters and picketing employees ordered off an open - to - the public shopping mall and a company parking lot.

COURTS LOWER decided against the property owners, basing their decisions on a 1946 Supreme Court ruling which held that "the more an owner opens up his property for use by the public in general, the more do (his) rights become circumscribed by the rights of those who use

Justice Thurgood Marshall, Court's only Black member, said in his dissenting opinion, "I am aware that the composition of this court has radically changed in four vears.'

Marshall pointed out that "it becomes harder and harder for citizens to find means to communicate with other For underprivileged, picketing and pamphleteering are the most economical means attempting to communicate, he said, concluding that "when there aren't any effective means of communication, free speech is a mere shibboleth."

McGovern beamed his approval, and then went on to announce his disapproval of the crucial Gary convention resolutions, while paying lip service to other resolutions steeped in the traditional civil rights language. McGovern flatly rejected the idea of U.S. diplomatic severance with South Africa. Rather the presidential aspirant suggested an expansion of the U.S. embassy staff for the racist controlled country.

McGOVERN also objected to the Black political Agenda's condemnation of Israel for it's oppression of Arabs and expansionist policies in Africa. In addition he disagreed with

the resolutions which downgraded the issue of "busing" in favour of "quality" education. These objections however did not appear to disturb the congressmen who obviously saw a political windfall in being able to claim what they handed over the "961/2" votes guaranteed which candidate the nomination.

Harrasment over racism charged by Black Journalist at Newsweek

WASHINGTON, DC Newsweek, a pseudo - liberal weekly magazine, has been found guilty of racism in the firing of Samuel F. Yette, its Washington Bureau correspondent. The ruling, handed down by the District of Columbia Office of Human Rights followed a six month investigation of the charges filed by Yette at the time of his dismissal.

THE HUMAN RIGHTS unit concluded that there was probable cause to credit the charges made in the complaint," and invited lawyers of both parties to meet refusal even to speak to Yette

settlement. The substantiated the writer's charge that Newsweek had denied two basic constitutional rights: "the right not to be racially discriminated against in employment, and the right to freedom of speech and press. that

contended Yette harassment and overt racism at Newsweek began shortly after publication of his book, "The Choise", which vividly exposes established practices of government and corporate racism. At the time, Newsweek bureau chief, Mel Elfin vehemently denied the charges which included his

early next month to negotiate a and the curtailing of his news decision assignments. The Newsweek editor Osborn Elliott boasted that their action would be justified when all the facts are known.'

THE FACTS, however, not only bear out Yette's charges of racism against selected individuals, but point up the true nature of institutionalized racism inherent in the American way of life.

Yette's victory to some degree established the fact that a single Black writer can take on an establishment institution and win, provided he has friends in the right places, such as Yette's attorney Clifford L. Alexander, (Continued on page 4)

The jubilation however lasted less than thirty minutes, and since that time the whole Black political strategem has been thrown into disarray and confusion. At the close of the press conference announcing the Black handover of delegates to McGovern, another press conference began across the hall in another office.

Thaddeus Garrett, an aide to presidential candidate Rep. Shirley Chishlom and Arnold Pinkney, a Humphrey supporter announced that they had polled the delegates claimed by McGovern at the previous conference and found the majority of them still "uncommitted." In denouncing the Black congressmen's act as hypocritical, they read a statement signed by Aaron Henry of Mississippi and seven other Black delegates claimed by McGovern in his "over the top" count.

The statement lashed out at the Black congressmen for going back on their Gary convention pledge to remain uncommitted at least until July 9, prior to the Democratic convention in order to decide

Presidential fund raising

WASHINGTON (LNS) Nixon's campaign fund raisers have really been turning on the charm and sparing no cash in the sscramble for campaign backers, reports Jack Anderson in a recent syndicated column. "Traveling first class, staying at the most fashionable hotels, winning and dining prospective backers at the most elegant restaurants and smoking the finest cigars, Nixon's men racked up an April - May expense account not to be believed." Air travel alone for two months or government planes came to over \$45,000.

IN NEW YORK, they stayed at the Waldorf Astoria (three visits cost them \$2985) and in Florida it was Boca Raton Club, a "watering hole for millionaires." But the cheapest place so far to entertain potential backers has proven to be the White House. For an April 18 reception at the presidential palace, the Republican Finance Committee reimbursed the White House guest fund a full

All in all Nixon's fund raisers have been quite successful. They managed to collect over \$10 million from unidentified contributors before a new law went into effect on April 7 requiring that all political donors be named.

Wretched Indian dregs in Daley-land

CHICAGO (LNS) - 17,000 proposals Indians live in the Chicago area making it the third largest urban population of Indians in the U.S. Most of these 17,000 are concentrated in the Uptown section of Chicago.

IN UPTOWN about 70% of the adult Indians population are unemployed, 25% work in "day -labor" temporary offices (when there is work to be had) and only 5% find permanent jobs. Insufficient health care, malnutrition, and almost no education are conditions they have become used to living with. The rate of both alcoholism and suicide is

The failure of government agencies to respond to their problems has given Chicago's Native Americans no reason to have hope. But in the past two years they have done much to help themselves.

The Chicago Indian Village is the result of such work. It was founded two years ago when a group of Native Americans who had no other place to live took over a parking lot next to Wrigley Field, (a baseball park,) and remained there months. Finally several evicted, they moved to a new location. The Chief of the Village, Mike Chosa, has demanded Chippewa, finances from federal, state and local authorities to deal with the miserable conditions in which his people in the Chicago area live.

Time and again the Village has been evicted but they have always relocated in an equally prominent spot.

City authorities have tried to pacify Chosa by offering token

that would guarantee housing for the members of the Village, but all of these offers, except for temporary housing for the sgatters have been refused by the villagers. Chosa explained that if he and his followers were to move into the housing offered them, the other 17,000 native Americans in Chicago would be left not only without housing but also without a symbol of their struggle. Chosa made it clear that no token offers would be accepted.

The inevitable showdown finally occurred when the Indian Village camped on the periphery of the Argonne National Laboratory, a research government

One Indian caseworker in Chicago sees it this way: "White people who thought of themselves as 'highly moral decent, well-meaning pillars of society have made many of our people ashamed of being Indian. They have denounced our religion and tradition as pagan, heathen and as barriers to progress and assimilation. Before the white man, there is no history of any Indian tribe having prisons, mental institutions, old people's homes, or orphanages."

...Licentious culprit still on the loose:

White woman tried to lead youths into acts of debauchery

"...In over 20 years in public education, this is the worst incident I've ever heard of."-Domenick A. Massaria, Principal, Inwood J.H.S. 52.

NEW YORK - After her last class 12 - year - old Yvette Williams went immediately home, opened the door of her apartment and sobbed to her mother, "Im not going back ever again, not as long as that woman is there!"

"That woman" is Penelope

52, a predominantly Black and Puerto Rican school on Manhattan's upper west side. On the day in question, Miss Williams held her regular art class for seventh grade pupils, a class made up of boys and girls ranging in age from 12 to 14 years of age.

ATEACHER OF DECAY

What happened in that class must be considered one of the most bizarre stories ever to come out of the N.Y.C. public school system and makes a sick joke of recent reports that Williams, a white art teacher the United Federation of

at Inwood Junior High School Teachers would pull teachers out of classrooms if parents came in to observe classroom work.

Students report that Miss Williams began the class by passing out to them pornographic pictures done by herself. Then, as youngsters sat in shock, she proceeded to discuss her sex life, demonstrating how she thought the female partner should react during the sex

She then suggested that girls stand aside to allow male students to move to the front of the classroom for "a closer

her clothes, inviting several boys to help her. Male students began caressing her while removing her skirt and undergarments.

At this point several girls dashed out of the classroom in tears to report the incident to the principal's office. When he arrived at the scene, an assistant principal is reported to have said, "they probably tried to rape her."

MASSARIA: She's been transferred to the district office. I'd like to talk to you about it but I'm not allowed to grant interviews to the press without permission from the district office and the community school board.

At the district office MS spoke to Dr. Edwin J. Haas, community superintendent of school district. He confirmed that Miss Williams is indeed working at the district office and collecting full pay.

MS: What is her job here? HAAS: She does filing, answering phones and other

MS: Have you spoken to her about the school incident she was involved in?

HAAS: No. MS: Has anyone in this office

talked to her about it? HAAS: Not to my knowledge. MS: You mean she hasn't been asked by anyone in this office to confirm or deny that the incident happened?

HAAS: Not to my knowledge. MS: Will you give us permission to talk with her? HAAS: No, I cannot.

MS: Why?

HAAS: In my judgement she notified? is not very well and as such she may say things that will only incriminate her. I think that as she is, in my judgement, a very ill person. I should not allow her to speak to the press.

M.S.: Since her condition is that bad, I assume you have someone watching her at all times?

HAAS: Oh yes, all the time, both I and Mr. Roberts (executive assistant to the supt.) and our two secretaries watch her.

MS: The pictures passed out by Miss Williams along with written statements by students are, we understand, in this office. Is that correct?

HAAS: Yes, I have them in the files.

MS: May we see them?

HAAS: I'd rather not. I'm trying to cooperate with you, but I'm also trying not to go beyond the community board's policy of not granting interviews. I also have to be aware that the lady doesn't have a lawyer now. When she has a hearing she's entitled to union representation and I don't want to be accused of trying the case in the newspaper.

Has the union been

HAAS: Yes, I notified them. MS: What did they say?

HAAS: When I told the union representative about it he said. "...it sounds unbelievable."

MS: The school's principal, Mr. Massaria, is willing to grant us an interview if he gets permission. Can you or anyone in this office give him permission to talk to us?

HAAS: No the community school board set that policy and I can't set it aside. They are the only ones who can give permission.

PARENTAL RESPONSE

Mr. Haas referred us to the school board's secretary who obtained from the board permission for principal Massaria to talk to us. At least a dozen phone calls to Mr. Massaria's office for an appointment proved futile. In each occasion we were told that he was "in conference." Why he never returned any of our calls was not explained.

MS found in speaking with students that many had not reported the incident to their parents. Surprisingly, of those parents who were told only one took action. She is Mrs. Williams, mother of Yvette Williams.

about the effectiveness of the U.S. minings of North Vietnamese harbors, Mr. Nib replied, "From the years of 1955 to 1958, the U.S. has put many mines in our seas, but over the years we have learned to clear the mines and re open means of communications. We have the right to do so."

Mr. Mih said briefly that "The United Nations has not right to intervene in our problem. Why not? Because we are dealing with Americans and the Vietnamese. Nixon must return to the Paris talks and negotiate seriously.

KISSENGER, THE NEO -COLONIALISM

The issue of secret talks with Nixon's number one aide, Henry Kissenger, was discussed in a Paris press conference by Hanoi representative Le Duc Tho (on May 12th.) He told newsmen: "Though more than onehundred and forty plenary sessions of the Paris sessions of the Paris Conference on Viet Nam and many private meetings between us and Mr. Kissenger, the U.S. aide has maintained its position of neocolonialism... Until the last

private meeting of May 2, 1972, Kissenger offered nothing other than the old eight points, instead he tried by every other means to maintain the Thieu -Saigon regime which the Vietnamese people will never accept. We have made repeated public statements and told Mr. Kissenger in private meetings that the government of the Democratic Republic of Viet Nam and the Provisional Revolutionary Government (In the South have never intended to impose a communist regime in South Viet Nam. What we want in South Viet Nam is a three segment government of broad national concord reflecting the real political situation of South Viet Nam.

We have no other desire than to see all Vietnamese live, when the war ends, in peace, independence, freedom and happiness, wipe out all enmity and together rebuild the country in a spirit of solidarity and national concord. I am sure Kissenger will not be able to challenge me on what I have said today.

.WHAT NIXON COULD DO "Contrarily to Mr. Nixon's statements, we have never

demanded a surrender from the U.S., we have never intended to humiliate anyone. We only demand that the U.S. side negotiate seriously to settle the Viet Nam problem on the basis of respect for the Vietnamese peoples' fundamental national rights provided for by the 1954 Geneva Agreements."

During these four years, Mr. Nixon has missed many opportunities to peacefully settle the Viet Nam Problem...Morever, before or after each private meeting, it always put military pressure on us, hoping to compel us to accept its terms. I will point out the latest case. While the two aides were arranging the May 2, 1972 private meeting, Nixon ordered fierce bombing raids against Hanoi and Haipong on April 16, 1972, but they (U.S.) brought no new proposal. They insisted on a public announcement that a private meeting had taken place. We recalled the previous aggreement that the private meetings should not be made public by either side and we empahsized that the U.S. aide should not violate that

agreement again as it had done the election year." twice previously. Mr. Kissenger agreed to that. But as everyone knows, on May 8, 1972, Nixon unilaterally exposed the May 2, 1972 meeting. Thus, the only conclusion possible is that, when requesting the May 2, 1972 private meeting, the U.S. aide did not aim at peacefully settling the Viet Nam problem; instead it wanted to use that private meeting to publicly distort the truth afterwards, to soothe and deceive public opinion, particularly in the U.S. during



War of repression in South Viet Nam

By Schofield Coryell

Paris (LNS) — PRG sources here in Paris described to me some of the extreme and desperate measures of the Thieu government in South Viet Nam — striking evidence of its growing isolation and anxiety: For example, the Saigon administration, I was told, is now, placing political prisoners around the walls of military garrisons as living shields against the Liberation Forces!

WHILE THE intense American bombing continues all over Viet Nam, in Saigon, martial law is in full force. A series of new security measures are being applied with a vengeance: the drafting of 17 year olds (in practice, this often means those as young as 15 or 16), the searching of houses. the round-ups repeated of dissidents and suspected opponents of the regime, day and night.

On May 27, the Minister of Social Affairs announced that the Administration was preparing to move hundreds of thousands of refugees to the Phu Quoc Islands and to labor camps.

Thieu is clamping down harder than ever on freedom of speech and expression.

stepping up the repression against newspapers. In the month of May, 165 editions of papers were arbitrarily confiscated, and the directors of the newspapers, Cuu Nuoc, Chon and Bao Nua were jailed for "subversive" views.

The Committee of Alliance of Nationalist, Democratic and Peace Forces-an anti-Thieu resistance group founded during the 1968 Tet offensive announced in the city of Hue in late May, 1972 that the Thieu regime is now literally taking the people's blood. The rate of wounds among the Saigon forces is so high that the need for blood is urgent, and the

administration is forcing people to contribute their blood to the troops.

The Thieu clique, moreover, has kidnapped thousands of democrats and is holding them without trial.

The Hue University has been closed down, and the students drafted into the Army. Over

2,000 Hue citizens have been deported to Paulo Condor (Con Son) an Island notorious for its "tiger cage" cells, where they are being held without trial.

Danang, the PRG spokesmen pointed out, the Pupils' General Union (an organization of high school students) announced on May 25 that the government had illegally arrested thousands of students, including Dang Thinh Tinh, Do Phap Luong and Thanh Liem, members of the Executive Committee of the Pupils' Union. Many students are being detained and tortured at the Thanh Binh Interrogation Center. (Ironically, Thanh Binh means "peaceful.")

In Ca Mau, a provincial capital in southern South Viet Nam, Military Police conducted extensive searches and round-ups on May 14-16, and forcibly drafted 400 people between the ages of 17 and 35. Thousands of citizens blocked the military trucks taking away the unlucky "draftees," and succeeded in freeing over 100 of them.

The PRG explained that the fierce repression in the cities is a reflection of the regime's increasing difficulty in keeping the population in line. "The Thieu clique is isolated from the people in the cities under its nominal control as well as in the liberated rural zones." On June 1, the Buddhists Students' Union issued a

On June 1, the Buddhists Students' Union issued a statement demanding that Thieu cease forcible conscription. On June 7, 32 mass organizations—including the Popular Front for Peace, the Women's Committee for the Right to Life and the Students' Association—publicly denounced Theiu's policies.



Insurance not encouraged

city leaders lash Blacks

RICHMOND, Va. - Its hard to believe that government officials, elected by the people to serve them in whatever capacity is needed, would continue to deliberately withhold vital information the people need that would enable them to survive in times of adversity.

As Hurricane Agnes whipped the eastern coast of the United States with a ferociousness devastation left that hundreds of everywhere, people had to be evacuated from their homes, forced to leave their valuable possessions behind to escape the wrath of nature. Many homes were completely wiped out as the waters of the James River mounted faster than the inhabitants could anticipate. No one expected the waters to rise to the dangerous level it reached in its victimizing process.

Businesses were forced to operations their close completely, their products ruined beyond recognition as uncontrollable waters, reaching a record height of 24 feet above the flood stage, lashed mud and debris across the lowlands surrounding the river shores.

Hardest hit in Richmond was the all-Black community of Fulton, where thousands of Blacks, already faced with substandard living conditions, were completely wiped out for the second time in three years flood waters. Total evacuation of the Fulton area, where poverty and slum housing are widespread, was necessary.

The waters have subsided now, leaving mud and refuse as the evidence of the chaotic situation which plagued lives

for days. People, trying to people of Richmond were not completely informed of the need to protect themselves and their personal belongings from the effects of the flood. Sources close to city administration personnel recently revealed the startling facts that exposed the callousness of their thinking when confronted with a choice of protecting lives of poor people or enticing new business into a blighted area.

City officials were afraid to make federal flood insurance availiable to city residents partly because they feared the revelation of a flood ordinance would make it financially difficult for industries to locate along the tempermental James River.

Although the insurance would be offered at a subsidized rate through government

hesitated to enter into the flood insurance program because it Insurance program because it was afraid the city's liability costs would be too high if a flood was to occur. Through a lack of correct communication, the city also felt that city-owned property would not be insurable. Its concern for the city-owned property over its citizens is hardly understandable in view of the fact that the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority (RRHA) owns only 10 per cent of the 800 single or multi-family dwellings in the Fulton area.

According to federal officials, RRHA's owning property in Fulton would have no effect on the purchasing of insurance by the other property owners. Richard Krimm, who is in charge of the flood insurance program, said that all types of structures may be covered under the federal flood insurance program which had been altered as late as March 1972. However, unsympathetic city officials,

Black, poor plagued by high

taxation and unemployment

CHICAGO - In this season of great economic depression, the Black and poor of the United States are plagued by many economic strangleholds.

Among the most visible are the problems of employment and taxation. Those few Blacks manage to find employment in these days are taxed so heavily that it makes their attempts at earning a living seem almost futile.

Even the federal government's feeble attempt at solving the problems of the poor end up in the pocket of big businessmen.

According to a recent study by the National Conference Board of NAB, Congress earmarked nearly \$500 million to be given to U.S. employers to train "hard - core unemployed." However only \$131 million was used, despite massive need employment of urban Blacks, which in many major cities has reached nearly 50 per cent unemployment, especially for young Blacks, 18 to 25 years

In addition to this tough

employment problem, the few Blacks who are working complain of the great burden of the rapidly rising cost of living and of giant increases in

A FRIGHTENING RECOLLECTION

A FACT SHEET distributed by the bail committee gives the background of Blyden's plight. On August 19, 1965. Herbert X Blyden was called at his home (where there was an illegal tap on the phone) by Det. Ed Fitzpatrick. He was asked would he come down to the 42nd Precinct in the Bronx, Blyden said yes. When he went downstairs, he found a number of policemen waiting for him...a stake-out. He was ordered to drive his car to the precinct with a police escort.

ARRIVING at the precinct, he was taken to a small room with a one way mirror, where he was asked to try on two different types of caps and prescription shades.

her that he had been in a car accident. She was brought to the precinct with her year-old

Herbert X Blyden was finally charged with robbery after being in the precinct for several hours; after having been drilled continuously and after having admitted nothing!

JUSTICE ON 'SWIFT SCALES'

On October 27, 1965, Blyden went on trial for robbery in the first degree (2 counts plus related charges). It took from 10:30 A.M. to 3:05 P.M. to pick 12 people to serve on the jury and from 3:05 to 3:10 to pick two alternate jurors with time out for lunch.

On October 28, Sonia Lopez, a rental agent for Alexander Rent-a-Car. was prosecution's first witness.

She testified under oath that the man who robbed her had been in the rental office for 20 minutes, and that he was 5 feet 10 inches tall and weighed around 180 pounds and wore a baseball cap.

Miss Lopez also testified that Blyden was not the robber. She said that she had seen Blyden before, because he had rented cars from her on several occasions, plus he had been into the office at 8 A.M. that morning to park his car in Alexander's rental garage and picked it up again at 10:30 A.M. on the 19th of August.

Fred Silverman, a customer in the car rental office on August 19 during the robbery, also testified that Blyden was not the man who committed the robbery.

Auto mechanic Dominick Maffucci testified that he saw a man run out of the alley and get into a parked car, which he had seen earlier being parked with a Negro man inside who had a beard. He could not say if it was a full beard or not. Yet,

the mug shot which was taken after the arrest clearly shows that Blyden was neatly trimmed and wore just a goatee

MAFFUCCI ALSO stated that he only had a side view of the man in the car and that he only saw this man for a few seconds 4 or 5. Yet he identified Blyden as the man driving a blue, 1965 Mustang, but he had no license plate number. The witness is also reported to have stated to Village Voice reporter Jack Newfield and others that "...all Negroes look alike

Detective Edward Fitzpatrick testified that after seeing a blue Mustang on 164th St., he found out who the car belonged to, went to the address on the registration and asked for Blyden. Informed that he was not in Fitzpatrick waited for 20 minutes then went to the 41st pct. and called Blyden at the stake - out

AN INFANTRY OF FACTS

Fitzpatrick repeated these facts before a U.S. District Court Judge at Foley Square in the habeas corpus hearing of May 11, 1972. He further admitted that Blyden was viewed in a one man line - up from 3:30 P.M. until 6 P.M., yet the D.D. 5 form (U.F. 51) clearly shows an arrest occuring about 8 P.M. of Aug. 19, 1965. Again on Aug. 31, Fitzpatrick was asked to reenter the investigation. Why? Was it because there was no evidence to link Blyden to the





Muhammad's Sixth Lecture on Theology of Time

Describes wheel-in-a-wheel

CHICAGO — Over 2,000 Black people were treated to the sixth of a series of lectures on "The Theology of Time" by The Honorable Elijah Muhammad last Sunday, at the new Muhammad's Temple of Islam No. Two.

HAVING filled up row after row of seats in the impeccably neat, spacious and calm main auditorium, the all - Black audience sat in profound peace waiting for that great one to appear.

And then came Muhammad. Wearing a brown F.O.I. uniform with yellow stripes running down the side, he gracefully and graciously moved up to the mike and greeted the people with the familiar but welcome Muslim greetings of "As-Salaam Alaikum."

"Wa-Alaikum-Salaam," The joyous crowd, already standing and loudly applauding, responded.

"You may be seated." He commanded very mildly with a wave of the hands, and then began settling down into another Sunday afternoon lecture to his beloved Black people.

It was on the eve of the forty - second anniversary of Allah's appearance in North America on July 4, 1930. July 4th, a devil's holiday, when Allah camd and made himself known. Muhammad would make frequent, mild reference to the coming holiday as he continued "talking" with his people on the mighty significant subject "The Theology of Time."

"I won't ask you how you feel," he began, with warm humor, "because I'm afraid you may say to me 'How do you feel?' and I'm afraid to tell you how I feel." No matter how Mr. Muhammad felt when he began his lecture, it's a natural fact that as he warmed into it, his audience began to feel "pretty good", as they say.

"You know I take my time." He began talking to them with the characteristic comfort of a man who's at home with large crowds of Black people.

"According to the bible and the Savior, Jesus never had over thirty people at a (single) meeting. So all those thousands of people you read of, that he was feeding, I didn't get that from our Savior's mouth." Therefore, The Messenger said, the one the bible talks about with thousands of people "must be me."

"I'm blessed with more people to listen to me than the devil himself. You know the devil carries the people" along with his way of thinking and acting. "But if I keep on being carried by Allah you'll see us in Soldier's Field (a 100,000-seat football stadium) pretty soon."

"WE INTEND TO VISIT NEW YORK AGAIN."

Then to the special delight of the New York area Black people present, The Honorable Elijah Muhammad hinted at future intentions of visiting New York City again. He told of a "visit to New York not so long ago." When, "We got into the biggest area they could find." He spoke of the 369th Armory. Indicating that he expects a much larger crowd when he goes there the next time, he said, "So like the Jesus... that little small calvary will have to move over somewhere to another hill."

Growing more and more comfortable with the

audience, Muhammad continued, "It's near the Fourth of July, and the people are getting off work" for the holiday. It's a day when people have their big day. So I say it's all right with us. But what we'd like to have is a little big day for ourselves.

Then this very originator of the popular phrase "Black is Beautiful," paused to survey his audience before saying under his breath, "Very beautiful. You look very beautiful from here."

"As the Lord said to Abraham, 'Take a look Abraham; take a look and see whether or not you can count the sand down there on the seashore; look up and see if you can count the stars above your head. 'He couldn't.' Then Allah said to Abraham "That's the way your seed shall be.'"

"You know I had to stand here a long time to count you." He said to the people who were listening appreciatively.

At this point the Messenger informed the audience that his wife, Sister Clara Muhammad, was making progress from her recent illness. He said that he had some x-rays of her and from them we think "She's doing fine. Allah is a Mighty Fine Doctor."

MUHAMMAD FEELS JOY OF AUDIENCE'S PRESENSE

Reminding them of his joy in their presense, he quietly explained to them that "I'm not in a big hurry today, because I know you're not going to work much more" because of the holiday weekend. I know you're going to be at home sitting down. So why not let's sit down here and talk it over.

Then remembering the early day of Islam, The Honorable Elijah Muhammad said that "Everytime I come out here I think about how we were laughed at holding our meetings in every place in the city...no matter how much we begged. they laughed at us; laughed at us scornfully.

"But today, all of a sudden, Allah picked us right up. Now we have the finest temple or church of any Black group in the country. Yes, no Black group has one as fine. And those Black groups are the friends of the devil. That's right. I said it right. All white people are devils. You may think some are good. Some are better than others. But that doesn't remove the very nature of them. He's still the devil. It's not his fault.

Comparing the white man to a snake, The Honorable Elijah Muhammad continued, "You may have a small snake, but he is still the devil. You may have a large snake that's not so dangerous, but you still have a snake. You can see in his little eyes and action that he wished he was a bad snake. Brothers, I teach you the knowledge of that snake. Don't trust any of them. They robbed us of our wealth, they robbed us of our justice, they robbed us of our freedom. But that wasn't enough, they robbed us of the knowledge of ourself. Any man that's robbed of the knowledge of self, that's the worst robbery you can have.

"I'm going to take my time today because I know you really don't have anything to do tomorrow. So if you get tired, go out and take a little walk around and come back, because I want to talk with you. I want to teach you that which you never dreamed you'd hear. And since you don't have so much work to do tomorrow let's stay round and talk to each other for awhile.

THE WHITE WOMAN AS MODERN DELIAH

"The bible says Deliah was a terrible tricky woman. She tricked Sampson going and coming, and Sampson was so foolish as to let her trick him. She said to Sampson 'Oh, Sampson, where lies your strength?' The Messenger said that was a hint for Sampson to beware, because "If she was so anxious to find where his strength was, if she was so ungracious as to ask him, he should have been so wise as " as not to tell her. He should never have told her where his strength was, especially since she was not one of his people. She tried to put one over on Sampson and he went back and let her trick him again. You are the same modern Sampson. Please, brother, do not let Deliah's sister trick you again. This means a modern Sampson and modern Deliah."

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad said the white woman are making false love to the Black man because "They don't want you, they don't love you, but are trying to get you to go to hell with them. She's only out there winking her blue eyes at you trying to deceive you. She doesn't love you anymore today than she did a thousand years ago. She just wants you to go to hell with her."

MUHAMMAD AT THE BLACKBOARD

Like a very skilled surgeon he had brought them up to the moment which they've begun to anticipate with intense interest: "Well," he said. "I guess I'd better get back to my board now. My board wants some company so bad it has moved over here by me." he said with deep humor perceiving that someone had placed the black board a little closer to the rostrum than it was on the previous Sunday.


"You have been told the meaning of the board; of the flag on the left (American), and of the flag on the right (Islam). You have been told the meaning of the American flag; the stars, stripes... You have been told the meaning of what you think are the stars (in the American flag). "What does that mean Muhammad?" You ask me. You should know what it means, and with that (you should also know) what the I.F.J.E. on it means." (The I means Islam, the F means freedom, the J means justice and the E means equality)

"I don't have any letters on the one over to my left, on the American flag. But we know what these stars and stripes represent. The one over to my right, it's so beautiful. Think about that. If I tell you I don't worship this flag I'd be making a fool of myself. There's not a fool that doesn't worship the sun, moon and star. And if he tones it down he'd be telling other than the truth... You do love that flag (Islam). You look for it every morning, and if you can't see it, can't see the sun, moon or star you'd go crazy. But they shoot up and tear up the stars and stripes everyday. No one can tear up the sun, moon and stars but God.

"The moon was blasted to pieces once before. And God said he could make another. But America can't make another. We had to make that (American flag) for her.. Their religion represents death. On a hill still stands that old rugged cross. If he calls his own sign of his religion an ugly name, why should you and I take it for ourselves?

"This sign (Black man hanging on tree) of his

religion makes you sick to find our people raving over that old cross. And this one opposite it the devil made for them. You must remember that you've been made double blind, deaf and dumb.

"Just think over that: giving the Black man a sign of that which he used to kill Jesus. Now he's made you a sign over there on the real tree. Isn't that something?

"Now we have explained (the two flags) and therefore ask you a question: Which one will survive the War of Armageddon?

"If this one can survive Armageddon, okay, then where will you have a moon and star" If the devil can destroy that flag over there and become master over you and sit up this flag (American) as the standard of the universe, where will you get life from?"

WHEN BLACK PEOPLE WERE NOBODY

"I'm going to do a little figuring where we left off (last week)." The Messenger of Allah said and then walked cooly and confidently over to the blackboard, upon which he wrote the number six. "We're going to work on it," he said of the six. So we're coming in to this afternoon with the number six. We want to teach you the knowledge of the science of six...This six was made in the very beginning of the creation of time. This was the number which was called time; when it was made about six trillion years from the beginning...

"We have now the number 6, 7, 8, 9 and the zero (which) counts for nothing until something is put there with it to make it something. So we have six over here, and zero over there. In all your figuring up to nine, unless you take some of these figures besides it and put something with it you don't go very far. But if you put a figure on this side of zero you have ten and if you pit it on that side you have one tenth. I'm not making fun. If I were a man to make fun, God wouldn't have chosen me.

FROM NOBODY

"So we have here one besides nothing and made this nothing increase 10 fold. Okay, if we put it on this side we still don't have much. It's a fraction. So Allah came on this side (left of zero) and got behind us and with His Number One behind nothing He made us who were nothing ten fold more valuable. And if we got in this figure (Nine) going forward, and reach up here and grab this big old nothing, look what it made.

"If our Father was made on the number One how did He get that figure six when one eas before six. How did He get the number one?

"If an atom was one, -we're taught that an atom was one ten thousandth of one. Then how did our Father get up all those parts of one to become one? I'm not trying to be a God over you I'm trying to be that which he made me.

"If the universe of the darkness of the space before light was created what was in that particular space before light that could produce life? What was there before space?

"My subject today is the Theology of Time."

"So many people believe we're fools because we believe in Islam. But that's because they don't have a knowledge of the time. Islam is not only your religion and my religion. Islam should be the religion of everyone. You should be careful laughing at Islam. When you laugh at Islam you're laughing at the creation of the wisdom of God. So from this day onwards please do not laugh at the wisdom of God when you're trying to survive on it."

"Allah is ready to attack America out of his universe."

"We must give account of death. We must give account of our actions against death.

THE FORCE AND

"If we saw one emerge out of darkness, what force and power brought it out? One cannot come out of darkness unless force was in there to bring it out. In the universe there is a force that moves seemingly unmovable stars. After so long the stars we see over here has moved over there. If that star moves from this point to another with a 10,20,30,40,50 or 100 or a thousand years span, what force caused it to move, since it could not move alone.

"The force of the actual space seems as though nothing is moving to bring us objects that are hidden to our view...We don't wind the universe up and bring Jupiter into our view. Jupiter is moving by force. There is already a force out there that's going to bring these things in space before our view. This (number) One was already here, (darkness). But nothing gave it to us untill the time brought it about. When time brought it about it merged out into our view into hidden in darkness. We don't know how many years it was there revolving life. It made itself out of water made in darkness of the universe. But without a fine atom of water we couldn't see life emerging out of space without water because you can't produce life without water. So therefore there's some water out there in that darkened space. How long was life out there before it produced form. You calculate how long life takes to make one

"You and I being dead over here in North America, and North America being dead so many thousands of years that we can't calculate the actual time by the instruments. So you calculate on how long it takes water to make one atom. Then you estimate so long ago.

"Are you understanding?"

"If you want to ask questions I'm fixing it up so you can ask questions. But remember they must be intelligent questions.

"If one emerges out of this Black darkness so that Black darkness can calculate itself.. and Black darkness is moving with instruments how can Black darkness calculate itself. Just imagine we're looking at this Black darkness, looking at it in space. Now if one produced himself out of Black darkness how did He produce Himself to come out talking, preaching and singing?

MUSLIMS TO BE NUMEROUS AS SAND ON THE SEASHORE

"What is the earth made of? The earth is a ball of finely ground stone. It has great stones supporting the fine stones.

"What did God mean other than His people when he said to Abraham 'Can you count the grains of sand on the seashore?' It wasn't that Abraham couldn't count the number of his people," But he must understand that someone put them out there and some one made them.

"Abraham was far from that kind ot mathematician being able to calculate on how many grains had been laid down on the seashore. Here we're dwelling on figures that will lead us into the universal nature of figures.

"These two figures (One and six) are the outstanding figures that we have. The one represents the God who created the heavens and earth and the other (the six) represents the same. How did that happen? He didn't stop growing. We didn't know how to overtake him. The six came six trillion years after the creation. So now we say we have six trillion years from the year one. Now we have this one and this six dealing with the beginning of the creation. And since we're working in the judgement time we want to carry on dealing with knowledge of the creation.

"I want to tell you the story of Moses and the wise man in search of knowledge. They went down by the junction of the Nile River... Moses couldn't go along with nothing the wise man did. The Wise man had told him he would not be able to go along with him. Moses couldn't prolong without asking 'why do you do that.?' Until he got to the junction. Then Moses learned that He (the Wise man) was the best guide.

"It's pretty sad that the father, (the Black man), after producing a son, (white man) looks at the son and tells him the end of him. Since America has prepared dangerous weapons to destroy the Black man. God has prepared destructive weapons for him (the devil).

"The Bible is good for you to study if you understand. But when you don't understand Allah will not leave you ignorant, Allah will not let you stay in the darkness forever.

MOTHER PLANE

"He raises up a man that will lead you out of darkness. So you're lucky. He raised up one in myself to teach you the knowledge of that which was prophesized. ..In the book of Eziekel there is prophesized about a wheel in a wheel.

"It's up there now. The devil knows it's up there...He makes planes so swift that if he could discover it in the skies and get back to earth and throw a rocket into it before it ever moves, he'd do that.

"He makes planes to search space with the highest speed known to his scientists. And this wheel in a wheel is so high up in the air that it looks dreadful. ..This is what they're trying to locate on the moon. If they could get a good stationary place on the moon and watch for this plane and could get out at it, in time it would never do any harm to the earth.

"This plane represents the Mother plane, and this corner represents the earth." he said, pointing to drawing on blackboard. ... Eziekel said he'd come out and drop a bomb.

The Messenger said that when the Mother Ship drops the bombs it'll be located about 20 miles from the earth. He said it will "be no more than 20 miles because" the scientists "want to use the earth's at nosphere to help the bomb strike the earth. When this bomb strikes the earth it will strike right into the earth. It has a bomb that's timed and a motor which automatically goes on and takes the bomb right into the earth to explode (once it has gone a mile down.) It sets up a mountain one mile high. Allah taught me that's the very bomb used to make mountains on the earth.

"Allah taught me that they have the same type of dynamite in the bomb that they used to make mountains on earth. It goes into the earth like an air hammer. And it doesn't explode until it gets into the earth.

"It was used to bring up Mount Everest. It is more powerful than the American bomb. America uses 30 per cent dynamite, but these poeple (on the Mother Ship) use a bomb that is equipped with 100 per cent dynamite just to blast up a few mountains. It will kill people 50 miles around and push up mountains on each side. It will go into action when America starts using her high explosions... This thing will come out and get them. Fifteen thousand of these bomber planes and they carry three small bombs each. Each plane will take these bombs over an area and drop them. They will destroy for 150 miles from where they are dropped...

"I have seen that plane. It's a powerful plane. It can dart in the sky just like a flying saucer.

"Right through the middle is a wheel which measures one mile, so Allah told me. And if you find me lying I'll give you \$10,000 out of my brother's vest pocket. And if you don't think I have, you can loan it to me and I'll pay you back. I saw this plane.

"This plane can move about into space so wisely until their (white people) way of trying to shoot it out of the sky will never take it. I think it has about four or five scientists on it. It is one half mile. You will see this plane... it has a civilization on it. They stay up there sometimes from one year to one and a half years... It's a wonderful, dreadful plane... The day it's seen in America, (you should) make haste

and run to some post.
"I stopped drawing this plane for many years ...But now I think I'll go back to it because they seem to be up there fixing it up to come down to earth... When America thinks she's going after this plane, the scientists will go forward and finish America. They (the devils) know it's up there. I sat down and talked with them about it... They have a drawing of it which they took from us to the FBI. They have it today. They know and admit what I'm teaching to be true."

Describing that fateful day when the Mother Plane will go into action, The Honorable Elijah Muhammad said.

"There'll be two scientists on every block, guiding you and telling you where to go. Better make haste and get to some post. That's a terrible thing. Those little darts (indicating point chalked into the picture of wheel) those little darts represents motors, great giant motors, to carry this plane. That plane is like Jesus was. Jesus could tune in on us. If they said go this way, he'd go that way. That's why they could never catch him. He knew what the Jesus were thinking and planning. Now they have one of every 100 over there who can tune in on us and tell us what we're thinking. You can do it yourself if you take time and go some place where you can concentrate... After a while you can hear... It is not that we are such people that we have to go and wait until something happens before we know what's going on around us."

The Messenger said that The Mother Ship is the same wheel which Eziekel said looks so dreadful in the sky. "These things are going into action pretty soon. The time is up for it to go into action. You and I being brothers, I thought I'd better tell you. You'll hold me responsible ...You'll say, 'Why didn't you tell us?' ...I'm going to tell you about these things now... It's not so secret that I should not tell you... There are two certain places on our earth" The Messenger said, "for hiding" when the Ship goes into action. "They were made just for that purpose, and they'll stay there a long time." However he said he wouldn't tell the people this time, but rather would "go home and think it over and ask Allah should I reveal to them what You've revealed to me."

He said that during the revelation and destruction of the people here now, "even the earth will act like a revelation has been done to her. This will make the world know they're not the God over the other world.

Giving his audience the same advise he'd given Black people forty years ago, he said, "Try to get out of the devil's name. The devil's names will be destroyed. God will give us names that'll live forever... That name Muhammad will be here till a billion years to come.

"We have other names that he taught me. Some are great long names; some are four or five inches long. But he says we don't need them (so long.) Reaffirming that "God and I love you so well that he sent me to tell you these things to make Gods out of you." The Messenger of Allah reminded the audience that "This is just what it's (the knowledge of God) is for; to make Gods out of you."

Muhammad confided to the audience that the Nation of Islam "had in mind" purchasing "two fast jet planes."

"We want those planes." he stressed.

Then he closed the historic lecture by calling once more for Black people to help him build a much needed hospital on Chicago's Southside. "I know you don't have much money ...But give whatever you can spare to help us build a safe and honorable place for you to go. I just almost tremble when I see you out here fighting. I want a place where your own people can work on you. And if you'll just follow me and give whatever you can, we'll have a million every week. And if you'd give half that much we'd have the Southside owned by you...

"Elijah doesn't want anything for himself. We want something to divide among you... I have enjoyed a brother's time with a brother. I've enjoyed the brothers and the sisters, so I pray Allah that we'll be back next Sunday.

"If you can't find you five to bring back, bring each other. Just put two figures back to the five (to the left of it) and bring me 500."

He warned the audience that "America's friends have become enemies to her. They're all looking at America with murder in their eyes, just as Eziekel teaches; 'Let us rise up and take her at noonday, anytime that she's not expecting us.'

"We thought Pearl Harbor was terrible. But Pearl Harbor will look like a gang of boys playing, when they come against America... I know what they've got planned for America, but I can't tell you all these things because you'll go talk too much."

What the Muslims Want

This is the question asked most frequently by both the whites and the blacks. The answers to this question I shall state as simply as possible.

- I. We want freedom. We want a full and complete freedom.
- We want justice. Equal justice under the law. We want justice applied equally to all, regardless of creed or class or color.
- We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the best in civilized society.
- 4. We want our people in America whose parents or grandparents were descendants from slaves, to be allowed to establish a separate state or territory of their own—either on this continent or elsewhere. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to provide such land and that the area must be fertile and minerally rich. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to maintain and supply our needs in this separate territory for the next 20 to 25 years—until we are able to produce and supply our own needs.

 Since we cannot get along with them in peace and

Since we cannot get along with them in peace and equality, after giving them 400 years of our sweet and blood and receiving in return some of the worst treatment human beings have ever experienced, we believe our contributions to this land and the suffering forced upon us by white America.

justifies our demand for complete separation in a state or territory of our own.

 We want freedom for all Believers of Islam now held in federal prisons. We want freedom for all black men and women now under death sentence in innumerable prisons in the North as well as the South.

We want every black man and woman to have the freedom to accept or reject being separated from the slave master's children and establish a land of their own.

We know that the above plan for the solution of the black and white conflict is the best and only answer to the problem between two people.

We want an immediate end to the police brutality and mob attacks against the so-called Negro throughout the United States.

We believe that the Federal government should intercede to see that black men and women tried in white courts receive justice in accordance with the laws of the land—or allow us to build a new nation for ourselves, dedicated to justice, freedom and liberty.

 As long as we are not allowed to establish a state or territory of our own, we demand not only equal justice under the laws of the United States, but equal employment opportunities—NOW!



THE HONORABLE ELIJAH MUHAMMAD MESSENGER OF ALLAH

We do not believe that after 400 years of free or nearly free labor, sweat and blood, which has helped America become rich and powerful, that so many thousands of black people should have to subsist on relief, charity or live in poor houses.

- 8. We want the government of the United States to exempt our people from ALL taxation as long as we are deprived of equal justice under the laws of the land.
- 9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

Under such schooling system we believe we will make a better nation of people. The United States government should provide, free, all necessary text books and equipment, schools and college buildings. The Muslim teachers shall be left free to teach and train their people in the way of righteousness, decency and self respect.

10. We believe that intermarriage or race mixing should be prohibited. We want the religion of Islam taught without hinderance or suppression.

These are some of the things that we, the Muslims, want for our people in North America.

What the Muslims Believe

- WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, but we believe that it has been tampered with and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have been added to it.
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they broas. 'c the people.
- 5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of the dead—not in physical resurrection—but in mental resurrection. We believe that the so-called Negroes are most in need of mental resurrection; therefore, they will be resurrected first.
- Furthermore, we believe we are the people of God's choice, as it has been written, that God would choose the rejected and the despised. We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgment; we believe this first judgment will take place as God revealed in America.
- 7. WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the

- separation of the so-called Negroes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we are free indeed, we should go in our own people's names—the black peoples of the earth.
- 8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation—of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed slaves".
- We recognize and respect American citizens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.
- 9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends". Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived

for the separation from the whites of this nation.

- If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the so-called Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.
- We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.
- 10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars, for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for.
- 11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of other nationalities are respected and protected.
- 12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.
- We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace together.

He was standing straight and tall. His arms were folded in the customary Muslim style. His shoulders were straight, and his head was held high. He had a smile on his face and I approached him, an honest smile.

"AS-SALAAM ALAIKUM, my Brother," I greeted him. "Wa Alaikum Salaam," replied Brother David X. Fontaine. We embraced and shook hands.

"How do you feel Brother David," I asked.

"Fine sir," he answered. "All praises due to Allah." Brother David X, is twenty nine years old and a resident of the United States Penitentiary at Atlanta, Georgia. He is a Black Muslim; A citizen of the Nation of Islam.

It is easy to recognize Brother David X and others who believe in and "practice" Islam as taught by the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, Messenger of Allah.

Despite the fact that all of the others, some 2400 inmates at the penitentiary wear identical khaki uniforms and identical shoes, Brother David X and other "practicing" Muslims car be easily distinguished.

When one speaks with other inmates at the penitentiary they readily concede that, "the Muslims who stick to what Messenger Muhammad teaches," certainly benefit from the religion. Brother David X is an example of benefiting from the teachings of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad.

When he was arrested in October, 1969, he had not yet accepted Islam. He had known a couple of Muslim Brothers vaguely by seeing them selling the Muhammad Speaks newspaper on the streets of Philadelphia and later Detroit, Michigan.

As he put it one day when we talked, "Brother I knew there had to be something better than what I was doing."

In 1967 he had started using narcotics. At the time he weighed close to two hundred pounds and was in perfect health. Prior to that he had been one of the best boxers in the Florida State Penitentiary, at Raiford Florida. Many believed he would "make it" as a professional boxer.

It wasn't until after he migrated North that he became involved with narcotics. By 1969, nearly two years later, he had a two hundred (200) dollar a day habit and had lost close to sixty pounds. As he put it, "I use to huy pure heroin"

If anyone had reahced a low he had. In 1969, three months before his arrest, Brother David X was shot. It was not until he was arrested that he received proper medical treatment. The bullet had went through his side. For months the only treatment he received was self - administered was self - administered penicillin and for a time he packed cocaine into the wound.

Today Brother David X is a new man. After years, nearly two years of "practicing" Islam he is now looking forward to leaving the penitentiary and walking through the doors of Muhammad's Temple of Islam.

He doesn't smoke, drink (prison made buck or any other intoxicant) and is 'clean' of narcotics, and doesn't gamble. He weighs 176 pounds and is in perfect health.

He said to this writer, when asked if he was ready, (meaning ready to soldier for Messenger Muhammad)" Yes sir, I know I am!"

Truely this is an example of the miracle of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad.



Ghettos becoming police shooting gallaries

Delicate 16-year old girl shot in the back

LOS ANGELES callous disregard for the lives and property of Blacks confined within the U.S. ghettos became greatly ghettos electrified in this city with the recent gunning of a 16 - year old girl, who was shot in the back as she attempted to flee the vicious onslaught of members of L.A.'s police department.

INVESTIGATION MUHAMMAD SPEAKS reporters revealed the events leading to the brutal shooting

appeared to be nothing less than wanton brutality and unwarranted harassment by the armed gunmen, who use the Black community as a shooting gallery with Blacks as their 'clay pigeons.'

Information furnished by Mrs. Dixie Griffin, mother of the wounded girl, revealed the two plainclothed officers involved in the sadistic shooting had constantly harassed and intimidated her two sons for more than six months prior to the gunning of her daughter. The grief stricken mother said the

into her home on previous occasions during the past few months without benefit of search warrants in attempts to terrorize her sons.

Gloria, who weighs less than 120 lbs, lies seriously wounded in L.A.'s Morningside hospital. The bullet fired into her back smashed through her rib cage and entered her lung.

Black youths living within the area, stated the two officers involved in the shooting seem to take pleasure in calling them 'punks,' 'niggers,' and seizing upon every opportunity to terrorize them.

Other witnesses to the brutal shooting described the actions of the policemen as 'vicious'

Situated in the heart of L.A.'s Black community, the area is heavily patrolled by members of the LAPD who over the past score of years have killed hundreds of Blacks under suspicious circumstances. In almost all instances the deaths have been termed as 'justifiable ' or 'accidental.'

During the administration of the late William Parker, chief of police, hundreds of Black hating whites were recruited with lavish enticements from the southern and southwestern states. Reports indicated that

most of these newly recruited officers were placed within precincts in the heart of the Black community. The murderous attacks over the past years bear witness to the deadly forces which permeate communities where these Blacks live under the constant threat of unprovoked and terroristic attacks.

witnesses stated the two sons of Mrs. Griffin were standing outside the window of a neighbor's home, talking to her children, who were on the

inside. The two Inside. The two officers stopped and accused them of burglarizing the house. After being informed by the owner of the residence that the two boys were known to her and that no burglary was in progress, the officers became enraged and proceeded to beat and choke the youths.

ACCORDING to witnesses, one of the youths was choked into unconciousness and other youths playing ball in the streets began to plead and beg the officers to stop choking

Witnesses stated that young Gloria, who was also present on the scene rushed to the aid of her brothers and was shot in the arm by one of the officers. Turning to run into the house she was shot again in the back. Although fleeing the deadly gunfire, the officers claimed she was attacking them.

It was apparent from the moment of her arrest that she was the victim of a political, racist frameup. The affidavit of Marin County District Attorney Bruce Bales on which the arrest was predicted showed that the only evidence connecting her in any way with the event of August 7 at the Marin County courthouse was the fact that the guns which young Johanthan Jackson

brought into the courtroom had been openly purchased by her and were legally registered in her name.

It was on this flimsy pretext that the FBI placed her on the 10 most wanted list and unleashed a national woman hunt endangering her life. Following her arrest, all of the repressive machinery of the state was mobilized against her. Nixon appeared on national television to congratulate Hoover for apprehending this "terrorist." Reagan and Rockefeller cooperated in rushing through a warrant for her extradition to California, shortcutting all normal procedures investigating the validity of the

Tracing the history of his involvement, he stated:

We filed a petition in the New York courts for Angela's release, asserting that the

Bales affadavit failed to establish probable cause to believe her guilty of any crime. Fearing the collapse of his case, Bales hurriedly assembled a grand jury in Marin County and secured an indictment as a means of circumventing the lack of probable cause. We countered by demanding that the New York court order Bales to submit the transcript of the grand jury proceedings and urged that they would show the indictment to be as unfounded as the prosecutor's affadavit. The court brushed aside this demand, and unpresedented burst of speed, five appellate courts, including the Supreme Court of the United States, did likewise, all

defense, it revealed that Bales had secured the indictment on evidence that added nothing to his affidavit. Yet, the trial court and two California appeals courts refused to dismiss the case for lack of probable cause.

It was not until 22 months after the charges were first leveled against her that a jury at last found Angela Davis innocent and set her free. But those 22 months can never be restored to her. Bail having been denied, 16 of these months were spent in prison, most of the time in solitary

confinement and all of it under maximum security jeopardized her health and would have broken the spirit of anyone with less dedication. determination and fortitude.

"Much as the apologist for U.S. racism and imperilism would like to have it appear otherwise, this record, far from vindicating the judical system exemplifies its role as an oppressive arm of the state.

"Nor is the action of the jury, with no Blacks among its members, a testimonial, as these apologists claim, to the

'Roots of War' shows power trickery

WASHINGTON, D.C. — At least two recent holders of the U.S. high office of President have liken themselves to honest Abe Lincoln, who was willing to "take on the criticism and anger of the ungrateful crowd in order to

protect its true interests," writes Richard J. Barnet in his new book, "Roots of War."

sympathy and support for the ruler's "willingness to risk unpopularity in the pursuit of the "right course" has been one of a conglomerate of devices used to manipulate U.S. public opinion.

In fact, Barnet writes, the warmongering rulers and national security managers "find it necessary alternately to frighten, flatter excite or calm the American people. They have developed the theater of crisis into a high art."

The rulers, the author points out, are aware of the public's lack of power to translate its mood into "quick political change" in the area of foreign policy, and take full advantage of the manipulative devices to thwart the will of the people when they begin to oppose the government's criminal wars against foreign states.

The "ruler", Barnet declares, wants "living men, whom he can make die before him, or take with him when he dies." The "need to rule," he continues, lies at the basis of this white supremacy psyche. In earlier chapters of his book the author points out that this

complex is engrained in the mentality of the imperialist nations. The white rulers react with stark paranoia at the slightest evidence or official admission of defeat or retreat.

This mentality, the author suggests prompted Harry S. Truman to call together heads of the important news services and leading newspapers to gain their support in 1946 for a stronger anti-soviet position, and some 15 years later motivated John F. Kennedy to begin bringing publishers from all over the nation to the White House for confidential two-hour luncheons. The Kennedy manipulative effort became known cynically on the Hill as "Operation Publisher."

Barnet, in describing some of the manipulative techniques of the U.S. war mongers, cited Nixon's use of execution which occured in North Viet Nam in connection with a forced landreform program, to warn critics of his war policy that they would have a "bloodbath" if the U.S. pulled out of Viet Nam. "By his third speech on the subject, the deaths had escalated from one hundred thousand into "millions."

official "leak. another technique Government sources "leak" information to the major news media in an effort to lend credibility to the news angle which they want to promote. Barnet writes. The event" follows the "lead. "To influence the public opinion in the 'right' way, it is sometimes necessary, as the national security managers see it, to keep certain news off the front page or to bury it."

"Thus, Nixon's sensational announcement about a projected trip to China seven months hence drowned out the news of new proposals by the North Vietnamese and the NLF in Paris, which was precisely one of its purposes.

Turning to more covert forms of manipulation, Barnet states that despite the clear legal prohibition on conducting propaganda activities in the United States, the Central Intelligence Agency has made U.S. opinion a prime target. The CIA, he points out, finances the distribution of thousands of free blooks to libraries designed to promote the war effort.

in the world community.

Accordingly, major face lifting projects launched last year have generated a steady flurry of activity among a small group of government functionaries charged with the task of superimposing a deceptive mask upon the country's now somber face.

Meanwhile, preparations for the coming extravaganzas go on with no thought to the paralyzing drain on the country's revenues, almost as if in mockery of the povertystricken hordes that inhabit this capitol city.

Black workers strife caused by Britain

By Charles Simmons

LONDON, ENGLAND - In 1900 the first Pan African Conference was held here which included some thirty delegates mainly from Africa. England and the West Indies. According to Dr. W.E.B. DuBois, "the conference was welcomed by the Lord Bishop of London and a promise was obtained from Queen Victoria, through Joseph Chamberlain, not to 'overlook the interests races

MANY THOUGHT that such a promise from the royal highness of British Imperialism at its height was at least a small success. But 72 years later the anti-colonialist struggles in Asia and Africa have whittled the former Empire down to size, and the Africans, Asians, and West Indians living and working in the "mother" country of the

and welfare of the native Commonwealth have given up on promises and are taking matters into their own hands.

A publication here titled: THE POSITION OF BLACK PEOPLE IN BRITAIN TODAY examines the conditions of Black workers, their education, housing, and their treatment by police and prisons in England.

Blacks in Britain who make up approximately two per cent the population, have the 1950's for two reasons. First, there was a labor shortage in Britain. So industry and government went out of their way to attract Commonwealth citizens and other foreigners, to come and work here.

The Aliens Order of 1920 was relaxed to admit foreigners under Ministry of Labor permits to work in certain industries. In 1948 the British Nationality Act gave free entry for citizens of the United Kingdom and the colonies.

Then the British corporations set up recruiting offices in Black commonwealth countries to expedite the immigration of cheap Black

increased immigrating here in labor. The second reason: The centuries of British imperialism in the Black colonies has impoverished those countries: unemployment and poverty forced Black people to leave their homes and look for jobs in Britain.

> AFTER THE SECOND imperialist war, Britain needed more labor for several reasons. Some industries, like the auto industry, expanding, and productivity could be increased cheaper by using more labor rather than modernizing plants equipment.

A personal viewpoint of Lumumba University

By Slava Tyne:

MOSCOW — In the early sixties the political seismograph in the West recorded a series of shocks — young people from the Black Continent began enrolling at higher and secondary educational institutions in the Soviet Union. What had happened to urge not only Africa, but the entire third world to start sending thousands of young men and women to the Soviet Union?

A WAVE of the national-liberation movement swept the colonial system off the largest part of Africa. Having won independence, the nations set the target of getting out of poverty, backwardness and ignorance. And this demanded the training of national specialists in the various spheres of economy. The Soviet Union gave them a helping hand. In 1960, on a decision of the Soviet Government, a Friendship University was founded in Moscow and named after Patrice Lumumba.

The Soviet Union's stand in

supporting the national-liberation movement on the Black Continent, the successes scored by Soviet diplomacy in helping to promote the adoption of the Declaration on Granting Independence to Colonial Countries and Nations by the United Nations ten years earlier and the Soviet advances in outerspace — all this made young Africans turn their eyes to the Soviet land.

FRIENDSHIP University

FRIENDSHIP University trains national cadres from 85 developing countries. The students all live together like one multi-national family.

About the university's contribution of certain privileged countries or nation have proved convincingly that human knowledge must not be the option of certain privileged countries or nations, but must belong to all mankind for the sake of preserving the progress of every nation, in the atmosphere of honest and

peaceful cooperation, international solidarity and friendship.

arising from expansion, there were many industries which English workers were leaving. These were the more menial, unpleasant and low-paying jobs. Workers were deserting them as other opportunities arose in this period of growth. An acute labor shortage existed in these unskilled and semi-skilled jobs, which had to be filled by workers from outside Britain.

"For some years refugees from Europe and Irish immigrants filled the required jobs. Irish workers were especially concentrated in their seasonally fluctutating, backbreaking construction industry, as unskill workers. Ireland is a source of unskilled, unemployed people for the same reason that the West Indies and Asian countries are: Ireland, like those countries, was exploited and ravaged for centuries by England. This kept Ireland in a backward economic state, highly agricultural, extremely poor, with massive unemployment. Since 1951, when large - scale Black with Commonwealth immigration began, the Irish Republic has

been trying to retain her manpower, and has made certain economic advances. There has been a decrease in High immigration, matched by the increase in Black Commonwealth immigration.

"The tendency in Britain in the most recent years has been to slacken its greedy demand for immigrant labor, and the Immigration Bill will help this. The decrease in need for labor is partly due to the economic recession, and partly due to an attempt by industry to modernise its machinery, thus reducing the amount of human labor needed.

THERE IS a logical continuity between old-style slavery and modern racist immigration legislation.





holding out the offer of partnership and eventual union under a "progressive" Caribbean federation. In the meantime, the pressing needs of Guyanese citizens are being put off by promises and clever sloganeering

MANY DIGNITARIES and other honored guests may be much impressed by Burnham's oratorial brilliance as he lashes out at "neocolonialists and imperialists" in firm defense of "the revolution." And especially so with the opening of the specially built National Culture Center complex along with a hundred newly built suburban villas.

Although they may never be given cause to suspect that much of the elaborate pomp and ritual being staged by the country's ruling clique these days is heavily subsidized by the arch - imperialist US government. Therefore, all will take place to the greater glory of the Cooperative Republic.

But, the sad fact is that the true makers of the cooperative movement have been allowed no place in this scheme, nor are they lauded in official headlines or included in official tours. Rather, they have been made the scape goats of the regime and a vehement campaign is now in progress to insure that they are neither seen nor heard.

Nevertheless, many still tell their story. And they tell of a time when they too believed in the dazzling rhetoric of Forbes Burnnam and entrusted to him their vision of elevating Black and brown men through the dignity and improved living conditions to be urshered in by

national cooperative development.

This story as witnessed and recounted by Black men pushed to the ourskirts of official "progress" is the story of a people who have struggled with great courage and dedication for the attainment of a vision as old as that of the freed African in Guyana. The same struggle goes on today.

The real roots of the Cooperative Republic dates from the struggles of the 1840's when African slaves freed from centuries of back breaking toil on sugar plantations, stauchly refused to return as hirelings on the estates of their former masters.

Instead they displayed ingenuity, monumental organization and discipline by using the five - year interim period between chattel slavery and legal freedom to pool whatever monies they could earn. During this period they were allowed to keep what they could earn on their own after putting in a gruelling day's work for their masters.

In this way, they amassed amazing sums and at the period's end established cooperative ownership over the estates they were able to purchase from ruined plantation owners.

Even today, a few of the old cooperative estates still survive, notably Buxton village, a few miles outside the capitol city of Georgetown, now viewed as a living monument to the courageous struggle for Black independence from white rule.

trained so far. Many graduates after returning home get good jobs, and some even hold high posts in their governments.

teacher-student relationship at Patrice Lumumba Friendship University is a warm one Future Latin American American agronomists, for instance, study farm crops of the southern zones and subtropics of the Soviet Union. Six departments train mechanical engineers, civil engineers, geologists, chemists, physicists, mathematicians, agronomists and lawyers. Practical classes take up half the study time. Students acquire professional skills and habits in investigating various phenomena and processes at the University's laboratories. CHICAGO In The Autobiography of Miss Jane Pittman, novelist Ernest J. Gaines has nobly attempted to trace down and manifest the historical, racial conciousness of US Blacks, through the symbolic re-telling of his onehundred and ten year old heroine's life story. Indeed, the book begins with the beginning of the end of slavery and the Emancipation Proclamation.

ALTHOUGH MISS PITTMAN is memorable, she is not that towering character to sustain the sweeping picture of our awesome history. Gaines lacks tragic power to reveal our burden and the deep, enriching library of our Civil War - slave history to sustain the mighty metaphor he has conjured.

The choice of the narrowing first person voice for narrating the story is all wrong, because Miss Pittman's limited voice; her experiences do not take her south and north - as we as a people have travelled - rather Miss Jane never gets out of 'Luzana.' Perhaps the book fails more than it succeeds, because Gaines has declined to explore the ranges of the fiction writer's vaulting possibilities upon his materials, via the power of the imagination. Thusly none of the characters haunt the reader's imagination and the book reviberates with the kinds of vignett - images one forgets shortly enough from such magazines as Readers Digest; the types of winning theme papers high school seniors write on the topic;
"The Most memorable character in my Life." You might expect to find Miss Jane on the sweet scroll for children's reading over the summer months...which given our current misery of foul literature is perhaps an indirect blessing.

Episodic in its revelation, Gaines might have wisely measured his limitations of power, research invention and sand - blasted his materials down to a manageable novelette, or perhaps a collection of short stories, with Miss Pittman as interlocking thread for these tales, in much the way Faulkner (to whom Gaines is embrassingly

South Pacific railroad power in Citrus world

NEW YORK (LNS) - Many sell most of the land for familyof the big grape and citrus growers in California's Central Valley do not own the prime agricultural land on which their farms are located. 150,000 acres of that land is leased from the Southern Pacific Co., which owns 2.4% of all land in California.

Southern Pacific and other railroad companies hold 12 million acres in the Western states given to them for free by the government in the 19th Century.

A group called The National Coalition for Land Reform charged recently that the railroads have violated the laws under which free land was granted to them. These laws required the companies to

sized plots at \$2.50 an acre or less; otherwise the land would revert to the federal government, instead, the companies held the land and leased it out reaping huge profits.

The attorney for the coalition said: "The Interior and Justice Departments are charged by law with seeing that the terms of the railroad land grants are enforced. They should apply the same standards of 'law and order' to these public land hijackers as they do to ordinary felons."

If the Interior Department fails to look into the landholding violations. the coalition plans to initiate law

Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania -A recent meeting of the Organization of African Unity has delivered a resounding defeat to the sell - out policy of dialog with the racist Vorster regime, a doctrine long fostered by South Africa and Israeli racists with the aim of spliting the organization and compromising the freedom struggle of millions of enslaved Blacks.

Convincing evidence of the policy's defeat came from Lt. The move came in the wake of

militant anti - government street demonstrations causing President Philibert Tsirana to step down in favor of the new military government.

New and vigorous opposition to any collaboration with the Vorster regime also came from the tiny nation of Lesotho. completely landlocked inside South Africa. The kingdom's Prime Minister Leabua recently rebuked proponents of the divisive trend by insisting that any such moves first seek the approval of the OAU.

The Lesotho Prime Minister is also said to have played an influential role in persuading President Houphouet - Boigny of the Ivory Coast to reconsider his initiatives made earlier last year in favor of cooperation with Vorster.


