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




Census Bureau figures released recently stated that the total number of Americans living on poverty incomes dropped from 28,000,000 to 20,000,000, the number of Negroes from 11,000,000 to 10.000.000.

POVERTY standards developed by the Census Bureau for non-farm residents were questionably placed at \$1,559 for a woman 65 or older living alone and \$5,440 for a family of seven or more.

"EXCEPT AT rare intervals, there has not been a national will to improve the lot of Negroes. What is happening, instead, is increas-ing bitterness of whites towards blacks as well as of the rich toward the poor, and suburbanites toward city dwellers.'

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



#### Beef Output Doubles

While Negroes Starve COLLEGE STATION, Tex. Recent data show that the median consumption of beef in the United States has almost doubled over the past 20 years, but other statistics verify that America's poor is not sharing the growing output.

AMID documented mass starvation of Negroes in the South and a physicians' report that hungry black women and children in Northern ghettos are devouring "large amounts" of starch and clay, a consumer marketing spe-cialists at Texas A&M University, Gwendolyne Clayatt, said production and con-sumption of beef could set new records in 1967.

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#### Census Bureau Finds Negro Population Younger, Growing Faster, Moving North

though a little more than 50 per cent of all per cent of all black people in the United States still live in the South, the latest Cen-sus Bureau figures indicate the balance will change before the 1970 census.

ESTIMATES made by the bureau also show that the Negro population is growing proportionately faster than the white population and on the average Negroes are vounger.

About 60 per cent of all Negroes in the U.S. lived in the South at the time of the 1960 census. But this percentage dropped to 54.4 per cent by 1964 and to 53.6 per cent by 1965, the last available figure.

The recent Census Bureau report shows Negroes, to an increasing extent, are living in metropolitan areas, even in the South, and within these areas in the innermost sections of cities.

BETWEEN 1960 and 1966, the bureau said, the Negro population living in metropolitan areas increased by 21 per cent, from 12,200,000 to 14,800,000 and almost all the increase was in the inner cities.

#### Eye Witness Tells of Storm-Trooper Shooting of Black Youths

Racial upheavals sceeping large and small urban centers across America have exposed the deep-seated racism of so-called "liberal" officials and in some instances resulted in the indictment of policemen for the murder of black citizens.

A South Bend, Ind., committee is conducting hearings into a treacherous police shooting attack on innocent black youths in a ghetto recreation center which resulted in nine injured Negroes, One victim of the unprovoked onslaught, a popular athlete, had his leg amputated a few inches below the groin as a result of shotgun wounds. The attack occurred during the second night of racial un-

South Bend's police riot squad-including three K-9 dogs-had been summoned to the scene of a car burning near the LaSalle Park Neighborhood Center, where "responsible" Negro youths and adults recently had concluded a meeting with city officials on ways to "prevent riots" and improve Negrowhite relations in the city.

Policemen, wielding shotguns and machine guns, ordered all Negroes on the street into the center. Eyewitness accounts of the police assault, called "insane" and "barbaric" by local Negro leaders, were related to MUHAMMAD SPEAKS as follows:

HE POINTED out that the center was jammed to capacity and some boys and girls had to stand in the doorway for a while. The police captain started waving a machine gun around and the dogs were brought to the doorway.

"Then, they fired three shots into the center," Low-ery went on. "About six of us were hit. Everyone tried to jam back away from the windows, and the police captain came in with his machine gun. He fired several bursts into the ceiling."

Several such reports came out at the hearing, yet not one policeman has been suspended or reprimanded for the wanton shooting. The Mayor refused to act on Negro demands, and received a letter of congratulations






causes, prevention and treatment of perio-dontal disease than we did years ago. This does not mean that people do not lose teeth from periodontal disease today. Nothing could be further from the truth.

What we want to stress is that if the patient today is willing to invest the time and money required to treat advanced perio-dontal disease, teeth formerly considered hopeless may be retained for many years. If you're one of those persons who thinks

the answer to all your dental problems is to have all your teeth taken out and replaced with complete dentures—well I've got news for you. You have eliminated the problems of tooth-

ache and periodontal disease, but I can assure you that you've gained another type of problem. (We will elaborate on this point when we discuss dentures and various types of replacement.)

THE TREATMENT and elimination of periodontal disease is spoken of as periodontal therapy. The object of periodontal therapy is to completely eliminate or halt the progress of the gum and bone destruction characteristic of this disease, with correction or cure of the deformity created by the disease. And finally, to set up conditions in the mouth and so educate the patient to the causes of the disease that the return of it can be prevented or minimized.

# Relates 'Security' for Women Found in America's Nation of Islam and Sudan

I received respect in the Sudan in so many ways, that it is difficult for me to convey its abundance.

THE MEN always stood upon the appearance of females in a room. At university functions, the female students would be served first. At the university library, there were young boys who assisted the females in locating and securing books.

Whenever we entered the administration building or had business to take care of, we were shown the utmost courtesy and consideration. We did not have to wait in long lines. We would be tak-en care of as quickly as possible.

One little story I'd like to relate concerns our campus cobbler. He had a small shop of about 5 feet by 9 feet. It was dusty, partly because it was constructed of sun-baked mud bricks. In it was one wooden case of shelves. Shoes were stacked in the corners and on a small bench bordering one wall.

THE COBBLER had young male helper, who sat at a table behind the wooden case. Newspapers covered

The world is bitter and tense, tottering on the brink of destruction. Internal decay has corroded her inner fibers, her shambles a re laid bare, forming a massive garbage heap of international consternation. What can be salvaged from the waters of the earth that have turned into blood and from the dust of the earth that has been beaten into fury by the warriors who have trampled upon it? Shall the moon be covered with sackcloth and the sun darkened in perpetual blackness so that the terrors of blindness shall be physical as well as mental?

ARE NOT THE peoples of earth following the way that was set in the times of a named Micah, who in his days, when there was no king in Israel and every man did what was right in his own eyes, said without a foundation of truth: "Now I know that the Lord will prosper me because I have a Levite as priest."

"Men in those days, as today, were searching for spiritual values and out of sheer desperation established form of religious belief and practice which was based on falsehood and deception but which served the purposes of those who headed the wayfaring communities.

INDEED, IF we study the story of this man, Micah, in the Book of Judges from the Old Testament, we will see that Micah and his day is synonymous with the present times. For in that day, organized religions and cult worshippers established their pretended codes of spiritual observance without the law of the prophets nor the guidance of divine authority. Yet, they obtained the illusionary composition of religious principles based on their own idolatrous views of what constituted right religious worship.

Today, millions of people believe they will prosper if they turn to the priests and ministers of Christianity and that its Protestant and Catholic representatives also will insure their spiritual prosperity. But as in the days of Micah, religious authority Micah, religious authority was not a matter of proven

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munications with God but was based on what seemed right in each man's mind.

EVEN THOUGH these modern representatives invoke the name and power of God in their doings and in their bestowing of blessings upon the people, this is a de-ceptive device of a play on words. This they also did in Micah's day. Though he had no authority to appoint a priest, he did so and estab-lished his organization of worship, which was shortly. thereafter, initiated by a tribe of people who were seeking an inheritance (because they were not given one by God, being out of the divine by nature).

Therefore, they set up their graven images and kidnapped the same pries formerly employed by Micah and insured him of security and income and installed him over the entire tribe and people who began to worship, not out of divine obedi ence and authority but out of the vain religious imagina exemption and file tions of the men who led scientious objectors."

NO GREAT divine scrip ture has ever allocated either the names of Christianity or Judaism as being of a divine origin or as being the rep resentative religion of God. The only divine revelation which constantly invokes the name of a religion that in God's own is the Hol-Qur-an, which does not hide the fact that Allah has chosen for himself Islam to make it prevail over all religions. And there can be no number of translations in one language or another which can deny the finality of these

'There were about 15 young musicians I knew who were not old enough to play in lounges and taverns. I took an interest in them, and de-cided to conduct a band workshop."

At the time, Robinson was working as a bus driver to pay his keep - as so many of even the most talented black musicians must work on daily jobs while attempting to make their music grow. For more than a year, he paid the rent on what he has made into his studio out of a weekly salary. Later, he began a series of concerts and productions rooted in the new music and blackness

Currently, he is producing an "Original Black Mass" at his Musician's Works hop Studio. The production consists of "free musical voices" from the workshop, the words of black Chicago poets and "modern interpretations" of the musical works of black masters. The production is put on with a backdrop of the work of black artists adorning the walls of the chamber. Rob-inson noted that the work-shop is based on "black muand art for all agesis a center of black culture."

THE MUSICAL play or production, Original Black Mass, he said, "speaks of black nation building, of where we are go-

lieves America is moving toward a "revolution." He predicted that the crisis would come to a head within "the next five years."

They will be-lieve in a black nationality as a race that does have potentials. They will come to believe that this race is just as good as any other. The emphasis on black identity, culture and unity will bring



An additional 2.5 million persons are estimated to have loss of hearing in one ear, the center reported.

These and other data on impaired hearing were obtained from a nation-wide sampling of household inter-

Impaired hearing was defined on a basis of the severity of hearing loss, using responses to a series of scaled questions related to the ability to hear and understand speech without using a hearing aid.

OF THE 22.3 persons per 1,000 population with hearing loss in both ears, 4.7 persons were unable to hear and understand spoken words, an additional four persons could hear and understand only a few spoken words, and 13.3 persons could hear and understand most spoken words.





# The Muslim Program

#### What the Muslims Want

This is the question asked most frequently by both the whites and the blacks. The answers to this question I shall state as simply as possible.

1. We want freedom. We want a full and complete freedom.

2. We want justice. Equal justice under the law. We want justice applied equally to all, regardless of creed or class or color.

3. We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the best in civilized society.

4. We want our people in America whose parents or grandparents were descendants from slaves, to be allowed to establish a separate state or territory of their own—either on this continent or elsewhere. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to provide such land and that the area must be fertile and minerally rich. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to maintain and supply our needs in this separate territory for the next 20 to 25 years—until we are able to produce and supply our own needs.

Since we cannot get along with them in peace and equality, after giving them 400 years of our sweat and blood and receiving in return some of the worst treatment human beings have ever experienced, we believe our contributions to this land and the suffering forced upon us by white America, justifies our demand for complete separation in a state or territory of our own.

5. We want freedom for all Believers of Islam now held in federal prisons. We want freedom for all black men and women now under death sentence in innumerable prisons in the North as well as the South.

We want every black man and woman to have the freedom to accept or reject being separated from the slave master's children and establish a land of their own.

We know that the above plan for the solution of the black and white conflict is the best and only answer to the problem between two people. 6. We want an immediate end to the police brutality and mob attacks against the socalled Negro throughout the United States.

We believe that the Federal government should intercede to see that black men and women tried in white courts receive justice in accordance with the laws of the land—or allow us to build a new nation for ourselves, dedicated to justice, freedom and liberty.

7. As long as we are not allowed to establish a state or territory of our own, we demand not only equal justice under the laws of the United States, but equal employment opportunities—NOW!

We do not believe that after 400 years of free or nearly free labor, sweat and blood, which has helped America become rich and powerful, that so many thousands of black people should have to subsist on relief, charity or live in poor houses.

8. We want the government of the United States to exempt our people from ALL taxation as long as we are deprived of equal justice under the laws of the land.

9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

Under such schooling system we believe we will make a better nation of people. The United States government should provide, free, all necessary text books and equipment, schools and college buildings. The Muslim teachers shall be left free to teach and train their people in the way of righteousness, decency and self respect.

10. We believe that intermarriage or race mixing should be prohibited. We want the religion of Islam taught without hinderance or suppression.

These are some of the things that we, the Muslims, want for our people in North America.

8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation—of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed slaves."

We recognize and respect American citizens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.

9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends." Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived for the separation from the whites of this nation.

If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the socalled Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.

We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed, in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.

10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars, for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for

11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of other nationalities are respected and protected.

12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace together.

### What the Muslims Believe

- 1. WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- 3. WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, but we believe that it has been tampered with and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have been added to it.
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they brought to the people.
- 5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of the dead—not in physical resurrection—but in mental resurrection. We believe that the socalled Negroes are most in need of mental resurrection; therefore, they will be resurrected first
- Furthermore, we believe we are the people of God's choice, as it has been written, that God would choose the rejected and the despised. We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgement; we believe this first judgement will take place as God revealed, in America
- 7. WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the separation of the so-called Negroes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we slave master's slave we should go in our own people's names—the black peoples of the earth.
