DAR ES SALAAM, Tanzania-Mozambique freedom fighters have launched a general offensive aimed at eliminating the remaining vestiges of Portuguese presence in Cabo Delgado and Niassa Provinces, and in creating conditions for the advancement of the armed struggle to the other provinces, according to reports from FRELIMO, the Mozambique Liberation Front


IN CABO DELGADO Province alone, a recent FRELIMO communique states, important Portuguese posts were almost completely destroyed, one aircraft shot down and a large quantity of military equipment captured. Almost every day Portuguese troops are ambushed.

'Our guerrillas, strong in number, arms and experience, register spectacular victories almost every day," the communique states. "The year 1968 is sure to be a decisive one in our libera-tion struggle."

Following are some of the re ports released by FRELIMO:

Mozambique guerrillas recently attacked an enemy post in Chiwaya, about 23 miles from Macomia. During the battle, most of the Portuguese troops ran away from the post and hid in the bush. Our fighters entered the post, removed the Portuguese flag and hoisted the FRELIMO flag. Nine weapons were captured: one W. German light ma chine-gun MG-7691; one Belgian machine-gun and seven Mouser rifles. A large quantity of uniforms also were captured





NEWARK, N.J. - "In cities across America increasing numbers of Black people are struggling to find out how they effectively can take over and control the areas where they live. This is the new, immediate challenge to the Black community and I think the only answer is that neighborhood control has to be accomplished from a position of power economic, political and even military if necessary," said Le-Roi Jones during a recent exclusive interview with Dr. Leo X, a noted Black dentist in the Negro community of Newark.

"I KNOW we can advance our cause with certain kinds of confrontations which might be intellectual," Jones verbal or said. "There are a lot of things we can do politically to take power, annex power, take control of our communities.

"But I think, in the final analysis, that we won't have any choice—the nature of the Caucasian is such that the only solution probably will be violent - not because Black people want violence, but because whites won't give us any choice. We will be forced into a violent posture to protect our lives."

Jones said he does not think it is even a question of Blacks wanting to get revenge against the white man. "The simple truth is that if Black people in America are going to survive, they are going to have to protect them-selves."

ST. LOUIS-The rich (white) nations of the world who got that way primarily through the ruthless plundering of the poor (nonwhite) countries have made no meaningful effort to create the kind of world economy that truly would support the "have nots" and enable them to stand on their

BRITISH economist Barbara Ward told a Washington University audience that rich nations continue to show "an utter unwillingness to think about development assistance creatively.'

She added that it would take an economic disaster similar to the stock market crisis of 1929 before governments will accept the principle that full employment is important to the stability of an econ-

The international development expert stated that wealthy nations still maintain protectionist economic policies, thus excluding underdeveloped nations from foreign investment gains.

MISS WARD, an Albert Schweitzer professor at Columbia University, warned of "crash" surface spending programs in economically despondent areas of the world that do not eliminate "economic barriers.


Olympic Team Funds



With 1.2 million troops at its command (including the puppet and satellite troops) the U.S. still feels there are not enough troops to defend the areas it occupies. When there is this acute shortage of troops for defensive purposes, where can the U.S. find the force available for an offensive? As it cannot go on an offensive, effective defensive is likewise out of the question.

(3) There is not a single safe place for the U.S. in South Viet Nam.

No place in South Viet Nam is safe for the U.S. aggressors. The people in the jungles, countryside as well as in the towns and cities are rising up in struggle, cornering the U.S. from all sides. Cities, the hide-outs for the U.S. aggressors, have become battlegrounds where the U.S. puppet forces are thoroughly beaten. To defend the towns and cities, the U.S.-puppet clique has to abandon the coun-tryside and the jungle areas, but by so doing they are only making the towns and cities still more vulnerable.

(4) The U.S. is unable to make up losses.

Like a bottomless pit, the Viet Nam war has swallowed enormous numbers of U.S. combat troops. An increasing number of forces and huge sums of money. The U.S. imperialists have so used up their financial and material resources that they are in great difficulties. U.S. expenditure, in its war of agression in Viet Nam, has risen to one-third sharp. The U.S. aggressors have budget. of the U.S. military budget. Never-the-less, the U.S. has not achieved any of its goals.

Even if the U.S. manages to maintain its present rate of production of arms and military equipment, it will still be unable to make up the losses in South Viet Nam, primarily because the PLAF and people of South Viet Nam are continuously raiding and shelling the airfields and ware-

numbers of aircraft. Large arms and equipment are being destroyed daily, and U.S. supplies are unable to keep pace with the losses. Meanwhile, communication lines are often cut, bringing even greater difficulties to the U.S. aggressors.

(5) Morale of U.S. troops is sinking fast.

The morale of the U.S. aggressor troops has seriously degenerated. A Western news agency report has disclosed that U.S. soldiers are jittery both when they are in the open and in dug-outs and tunnels. They even quiver when they board planes to withdraw from scenes of attack This nervousness of the U.S. troops is growing and even the officers have lost their confidence and are sick and tired of "the



Behind the Olympic Boycott Movement

Part III: The Black Athlete

When Professor Harry Edwards first began spreading the idea of an Olympic boycott, his aim was not directed solely against virulent racism practiced upon Black athletes in the American sporting

EDWARDS, like many militant Black people across the country and the world, was aiming at inhuman oppression and exploitation of non-whites the earth over

Although his songs now resound with the strains of Black Power rhetoric, he admits he once thought freedom, justice and equality could be achieved through the "We Shall Overcome" refrain. Like a growing number of his brothers and sisters, his hope was shattered by the harsh grumblings of unyielding white racism.

"Like many of the other Black people in this society, I once bought this theory of integration," he recalls. "I once thought that somehow it was possible for the slave to integrate with the master to share the power of the house

"BUT, I FOUND this was only a theory ... and we don't live in theory, we live in everyday fact. It is time that people quit telling this lie that suddenly Black people are going to be integrated. Black people should start to develop their own communities and realize they can't get any place with a dream of integration."







TAKING long intervals between eating meals makes it better for you, because long intervals between meals and drinks give the poison in the body time to weaken before a new addition of poisonous food and drinks.

YOU could not imagine a more wicked thing to do than for someone to take a good food for innocent people — from the cradle to old age — and poison it so that the eater and the drinker cannot enjoy good health and will be at the hospital doorstep where they will be denied immediate service (especially so-called Negroes).

Just as one can't go around with the arm, the leg or any other part of the body in a strained position, the same is true of the jaws.

The jaw muscles have a certain, definite length to which they can be set. It is the dentist's job to find this optimum position of the jaws and then build the teeth within this limit. By so doing, the muscles can do their work cor-

Confessions of A Black GI

Part ∐

As a Black man serving in Viet Nam, David Tuck, 25, found himself in the midst of the most inhuman and ghastly military action in recent history.

In the second installment in this series, Tuck continues his testimony before the Russell International War Tribunal in Roskilde, Copenhagen, conducted by world humanitarian and philosopher, Lord Bertrand Russell, in cooperation with peter Weiss, Swedish playwright, and Jean Paul Sartre, writer and modern philosopher.

In the first installment. Tuck told the tribunal of watching in horror as a Vietnamese prisoner of the undeclared war in Viel Nam was flung from an American helicopter in flight and witnessed South Vietnamese government soldiers torture prisoners.

HALIMI: Mr. Tuck, do you know how they separated the population? That is, how did you decide who was Viet Cong, who was civilian and so on, and what did you do after you had distinguished them?

TUCK: It was standard operation policy when in what we call V.C. country, that is, areas which were under control of the V.C. to surround a village and to go in and assemble the inhabitants in a bunch in the center of the village.

All young men who looked like they were able to wear arms we sent them away in helicopters to be interrogated by the South Vietnamese. The women and the children we sent to a refugee camp. Also it was common practice that if we received any shots from a village to have what we call a "mad minute." This means that for one minute everybody would cut loose tanks, machineguns and everything they had into this village, because the way we had assumed that until proven otherwise every Vietnamese

troops spray gas into tunnels. Can you specify what you mean?

TUCK: It was frequently when we were on an operation we would find a whole lot of tunnels -and-uh, a lot of times we did not know whether there were V.C. in there or not. My outfit did not have such men as they have further south as they call American Army. In particular, did not have such men as they the tunnel rats.

So what we would have to do. we would have to use tear gas to bring them out. A lot of time it would be women and children besides the V.C. in there. But most-but then again a lot of times it would only be women and children.

The tear gas does not kill anyone as long as they can get out to the fresh air; it just irritates them. Uh—as far as I know, tear

gas was the only chemical agent HALIMI: Mr. Tuck, you have being used to bring these people spoken of helping American out of the tunnel.

HALIMI: The Tribunal can question him on specifics, but I would like to ask Mr. Tuck two general questions. The first, You are black, and I would like you to tell the Tribunal if you sensed, during operations, a segregation -a discriminaton between yourcould you explain the advantages the others had over you?

TUCK: I would say that while there was not any segregation, if anything it was over-integrated. What a lot of people do not realize is that most of the soldiers fighting in the infantry over there are Black soldiers. In my particular outfit, it was 117 out of 156 were black soldiers.

this old pretext that if I got an education and a masters degree somehow I would be integrated the upper 5 per cent of the entire population of the country.'

It didn't work out that way. With a prestige job and a com-fortable salary (by standards sefor Black people), the six-foot, eight-inch ex-athlete and scholar learned that he was no better off or different than when he was just a child struggling in the East St. Louis slums

"I FOUND that even after I enslaved by the system. I found that I could have a million dol-lars, but I would still be forced to abide in a cesspool of indignation and racial white supremacy," he confides.

He is not ashamed of having attained his academic heights, nor does he feel it was useless. In fact, he is continuing work on a doctorate. However, he is doing so with the idea of using his learning to help his people in their drive to dignity.

"The point is not to use these talents trying to get into a white middle-class bag, but to turn these talents back into the Black community and develop that commu-nity to the point where some whites will have to go to LBJ to pass anti-discrimination laws to let whitey live in it," he explains.

THE SAN JOSE State professor is not promoting segregation. He is urging Black people to face and begin to work with a situation that already exists in the United

States.
"The Black community IS separated from the structure of America," he says. "If we were have to control all institutions inside, we wouldn't be catching the Hell we're catching. I am simply proposing that we forget about integration and develop our own communities and not wait for something better to come along because we have to live in these

communities."
"This means," he emphasizes, "that I am pro-Black, I am antiwhite and anti-NEGRO when it comes to the question of the survival of Black people."

When Harry Edwards talks about developing the Black community, he means "we have to take over, by whatever means necessary, the institutions of Black communities and make sure they are operated for Black people, by Black people, with Black people reaping the benefits. We



ing for the white man. If you are working for the white man, you are working against the Black man, and there is no two ways about that.

"Anything that's being done in America, there's a Black man who can do it, or can find out how to do it. And this includes even the use of atomic power.

"MY organic chemistry teacher at Howard, Percy Barnes, worked with the Manhattan project. He helped fashion it. It's true that few of us knew this. This is the lack of communication which is so evident.

"The only way Blacks can communicate—with the glaring excep-tion of MUHAMMAD SPEAKS newspaper—is by word of mouth. That's why a person like Rap Brown is rendered so helplessbecaue they won't let him ex-press his views over radio or television. And the cracker says, 'I'm not going to hear any more of it.'

Jones asserted that the first step that must be taken - which really seems to be the hardest step-is to find a common denominator by which Black men can come together.

"I THINK that in order for us to really come to grips with our problem," Jones said, "it is essential that we understand who we are, where we come from and how we got into this situation."

He said the African influence today is healthy in the sense that it leads the inquisitive Black mind to investigate his past and go back beyond Jamestown's slave colony.

"We come from another continent. Our needs, our desires once were suited to that continent and our history is as old as this planet. If we can find out who we were when we had great power, we might find out how to get it

"PUT YOUR mind back where it was, and it's not going back in time, but just to repossess the knowledge and sciences which once were ours. That's what always symbolized to me the identification with African or Eastern philosophy and a way of living.

"With this knowledge, we can again assume our place in the world," LeRoi concluded.

The militancy of the movement is not likely to tolerate opposition from within the community, the professor adds. The time is rapidly approaching when the entire community will have to work for the good of the whole.

"The thing the militants are beginning to realize," he says, "is that they must try to educate the Uncle Toms. And if this fails, there is every likelihood that these people will not be considered Uncle Toms but traitors."

He said there are already signs that such will occur. He recalls the Black boycott protest to the white supremacy policies of the New York Athletic Club during a recent NYAC track meet.

"We had a hint of this in New York, when one Negro athlete tried to cross the picket line which was protesting racial inhumanity to Black athletes in New York. The NYAC is one of the richest clubs in the world, and it has exploited and used Black athletes for the last 100 years. This Negro tried to cross the picket line in a U.S. Air Force



What the Muslims Want

This is the question asked most frequently by both the whites and the blacks. The answers to this question I shall state as simply as possible.

1. We want freedom. We want a full and complete freedom.

2. We want justice. Equal justice under the law. We want justice applied equally to all, regardless of creed or class or color.

3. We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the best in civilized society.

4. We want our people in America whose parents or grandparents were descendants from slaves, to be allowed to establish a separate state or territory of their own—either on this continent or elsewhere. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to provide such land and that the area must be fertile and minerally rich. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to maintain and supply our needs in this separate territory for the next 20 to 25 years—until we are able to produce and supply our own needs.

Since we cannot get along with them in peace and equality, after giving them 400 years of our sweat and blood and receiving in return some of the worst treatment human beings have ever experienced, we believe our contributions to this land and the suffering forced upon us by white America, justifies our demand for complete separation in a state or territory of our own.

5. We want freedom for all Believers of

5. We want freedom for all Believers of Islam now held in federal prisons. We want freedom for all black men and women now under death sentence in innumerable prisons in the North as well as the South.

We want every black man and woman to have the freedom to accept or reject being separated from the slave master's children and establish a land of their own.

We know that the above plan for the solution of the black and white conflict is the best and only answer to the problem between two people. 6 We want an immediate end to the police brutality and mob attacks against the so-called Negro throughout the United States.

We believe that the Federal government should intercede to see that black men and women tried in white courts receive justice in accordance with the laws of the land—or allow us to build a new nation for ourselves, dedicated to justice, freedom and liberty.

7. As long as we are not allowed to establish a state or territory of our own, we demand not only equal justice under the laws of the United States, but equal employment opportunities—NOW!

We do not believe that after 400 years of free or nearly free labor, sweat and blood, which has helped America become rich and powerful, that so many thousands of black people should have to subsist on relief, charity or live in poor houses.

We want the government of the United States to exempt our people from ALL taxation as long as we are deprived of equal justice under the laws of the land.

9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

Under such schooling system we believe we will make a better nation of people. The United States government should provide, free, all necessary text books and equipment, schools and college buildings. The Muslim teachers shall be left free to teach and train their people in the way of righteousness, decency and self respect.

10. We believe that intermarriage or race mixing should be prohibited. We want the religion of Islam taught without hinderance or suppression.

These are some of the things that we, the Muslims, want for our people in North America.

8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation — of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed slaves."

We recognize and respect American citizens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.

9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends." Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived for the separation from the whites of this nation.

If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the socalled Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.

We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed, in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.

10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars, for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for.

11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of other nationalities are respected and protected.

12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of the Muslims.

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace together.

What the Aluslims Believe

- WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- 3. WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, but we believe that it has been tampered with and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have been added to it.
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they brought to the people.
- 5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of the dead—not in physical resurrection—but in mental resurrection. We believe that the socalled Negroes are most in need of mental resurrection; therefore, they will be resurrected first
- Furthermore, we believe we are the people of God's choice, as it has been written, that God would choose the rejected and the despised. We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgement; we believe this first judgement will take place as God revealed, in America
- 7. WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the separation of the so-called Negroes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we are free indeed, we should go in our own people's names—the black peoples of the earth.
