## Brother Shumate Fears No Attackers Because 'Will of Allah' Rules All

NEWARK - Matthew X Shumate is one of few Black foremen in the construction industry. In the fall of 1965 he was at work on a job in Elizabeth, New Jersey, supervising a crew of 35 laborers-five African American, the rest Italian. One day an elder Black laborer was coming down the ramp with a big load of concrete and a young Italian laborer was coming up the ramp with an empty "buggy." Foreman Shumate called to the Italian to pull over to the side and let the other worker with the load by. The Italian cursed his foreman and then attempted to attack him from behind as he walked away.

THE ITALIAN lad threw a couple of punches at his Black boss, who successfully rolled the blows and responded with a couple of smacks of his own with a shovel he was carrying. The Italian sustained a couple of broken ribs and a collapsed lung, and is reportedly still receiving treatment today.

The contractor, who was on the scene and witnessed the attempted attack on Shumate, told his foreman that Shumate would have been less than a man if he hadn't defended himself.

Shumate didn't know that what happened in 1965 at the construction site had marked him to be murdered until a couple of months ago. It was then he learned by reading the papers that a Mafia "family" had discussed in several meetings how to get him. Rosario Cocchiaro, whom Shumate defended himself from in the construction site fight, is the son of Frank Cocchiaro, identified as a member of the Samuel DeCavalcante crime "family."

The Mafia usually retaliates against anyone who

rightly or wrongly hurts a "family" member, but in this case there was a major factor to consider. The DeCavalcante "family's cause for concern

was that Brother Shumate is a follower of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. The FBI report said, that the Mafia feared "an all-out war in Elizabeth," and "decided to let the incident 'cool off' for a month, and persuaded the interested family members to take no immediate action '

Of course, Shumate knew nothing of this plot to take his life in revenge until nearly four years later. Still at the time of the construction site fight and since, he feels no fear. As he puts it; "I am a strong believer in Allah and Muhammad is his Messenger, I don't believe anything could happen to me unless it is the will of Allah."

Born in South Carolina, Shumate migrated to New Jersey 25 years ago. Ever since he left the farm in 1940, he has been involved in the building trades. where a restrictive union policy keeps almost all Blacks out of the good-paying jobs and where a strong Mafia influence is present.

Shumate, who is a half inch shorter than six feet and weighs 229 pounds, still works as a foreman in the construction industry. He lives in a comfortable and beautiful home in Newark with his wife, two sons and a daughter.

One of Shumate's sons has been continuously harrassed for over a year by a couple of Italian city cops-but he refuses to be provoked into any incident. Otherwise, there has been no trouble as a result of the construction site fight.
