Black Writer Predicted Victory for Muhammad Ali

ST. LOUIS, Mo. — When a land, sea or air and always powerful U.S. clique blocked has. Muhammad Ali from fighting in the United States, a black sports writer here blasted critics of the Muslim athlete and asserted that Muhammad again would fight before enthusiastic crowds in America.

THE WRITER, ex-boxer Louis "Kid" Gray, said in a July 7, 1966, edition of the St. Louis American, that "those who say American boxing fans will boycott Mularmed are wrong" hammad are wrong.

Gray took particular issue Gray took particular issue with a statement by former heavyweight champion, Joe Louis, who said, "the theaters would not show his (Muhammad's) fights and I don't think the public would pay money to see him perform. Not now anyway. He'll have to stay in Europe if he wants to fight."

Joe Louis went on to say the American public was disillusioned by Muham-mad's bouts with the selective service system.

"Any student of boxing history," Gray wrote, "will refute that theory any day, anytime!

"JOE LOUIS fails to realize that the true boxing fan supports boxing regardless of who the participants are and without regard for what any pressure group thinks."

"If it is a fight worth paying to see, "Gray continued, "the ardent followers of the sport support it whether on boxing!

"Muhammad All's statement is no different from the thinking of millions of Americans. Congress has never officially declared war and if the truth is seriously sought for, does not agree with the country's involvement in Viet Nam's internal affairs."

Gray pointed out that Jack Dempsey, is referred to as one of the greatest — if not the greatest — past heavyweight champions.



An African Appraises the Plunderers

Enslavers?

"The British would rather murder every black man in Africa than give up their stranglehold on our mineral and other wealth," said Ond-wasi Namulanda, a Kenyan student presently studying at the Illinois Institute of Technology in Chicago.

"IT IS very easy to criticize Kenyans and Rhodesians, who are in the vast majority in their countries, for failing to rise up and destroy the British oppressors," he continued. "But one must understand the nature of the British and the odds against a black uprising.

"The British kill ruthlessly," he emphasized "Merci-lessly and without remorse, they kill. They kill men, women, children, entire vil-lages. We have seen this; we know. They murder black people as though they were insects

"No nation of people in the world are more murderous than the British. Would it not be foolhardy for Africans go headstrong into a rebellion when they know the reprisals, the bloodshed, the killings, the loss of one's family and loved ones which would result in the event of failure?

Mr. Namulanda asserted, however, that there still is a growing movement to cast soft-drink bottle. MILD-mannered, spoken African, Mr. Namulanda told a MUHAMMAD SPEAKS reporter who was visiting his home on Chicago's South side that the greatest thing about Africa today is the growing awareness of the people.

"We know Europeans are stealing us blind," he said. "They get rich from cheap labor and practically-free minerals which they plunder from our soil. African peo-ple, even the peasants of the countryside, are aware of this and planning for the day when the proceeds of Africa will go to Africans. This is heartening."

Namulanda has been in the United States six years. He said he quickly learned about American racial big-otry—"the hard way."

"I came first to the University of Nebraska in Omaha study engineering," he said. "Thinking that this was in the Northern part of America one evening I went to a restaurant, not knowing



black people were not served there.

"I WAS there only a few minutes before a white man sneaked up behind me and soft-drink bottle. I was man picked me up out of the gutter and brought me to a hospital. I was suffering from a cut which required six stitches and had a severe concussion."

The young black student lowered his head and, with his right index finger, pointed to a wide scar on the crown of his head.

He filed a complaint in an Omaha court, but the judge said he had no witnesses and threw out the case. He went to the British Consulate -Kenya at the time was still under British rule — but heard no more of the case.

"I was convinced Nebraska was a terrible state, so I left school—having missed most of my classes that semester because of my hospitalization — and went to Lima, Ohio."

WASHINGTON, D.C.—Statistics show that "black men ly to be drafted as are acceptable white men," states ice System. Sheila Ryan in an article, "Who Gets Drafted?" appearing in a recent edition of the Vietnam News

RYAN POINTS out that some 16 per cent of all U.S. draftees in 1965 were Negro, although black people constitute only some 11 per cent of the population. She says one-third of the next 400,000 draftees will be Negroes.

"During the period from December, 1965, to Febru-ary, 1966, only 2.1 per cent of U.S. conscripts were college graduates, though these men constitute about 13 per cent of the draft-age popula-tion," she continues. "Men with only high school diplomas were some 10 times as vulnerable to the draft as men with college degrees, constituting some 62.1 per cent of all draftees."

While Negroes com-prise about 13 per cent of men in the Army, Negro Army casualties in Viet Nam have comprised about 18 per cent of total casualties. (Pentagon data assert 22 to 25 per cent of all casualties in Viet Nam are Negroes).



Trends in the News

SIR BERNARD LOVELL, director of Britain's Jodrell Bank radio telescope station, appealed to the United States and Russia to call off their moon race and join together in space exploration.

"It must count as one of the deepest follies of all time for an enterprise of such complexity and expense to be carried out separately," he said in an article published by the London Times.

THE CONTINUING auto-sales slump resulted in a 6% decline in General Motors Corp.'s indicated fourth quarter earnings compared with the like 1965 quarter. The giant auto maker also reported a 16% profit drop for the year 1966—the first time in five years that GM profits didn't set a record.

DR. W. ALPHAEUS Hunton, an American Negro scholar who worked for three years in Ghana as director of the Encyclopedia Africana project initiated by the late Negro leader W.E.B. Du Bois, says that the project is still alive despite his own ouster by the Ghanaian regime.

ENOUGH SALT TO last the world for thousands of years, along with millions of tons of sulfur and billions of barrels of crude oil, lies buried in underground formations along the nation's gulf coast, the department of interior's bureau of mines disclosed.

Announcing the results of a survey of 329 salt domes in Texas, Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, and offshore tidelands, the bureau said the recovery of 50 per cent of the salt in only 40 of the domes would supply United States needs for about 26,000 years at current rates of use.

ZAMBIA'S MINES, THE world's biggest exporters of copper, are being slowly strangled by the Rhodesian crisis, racial strife, and strikes. Production is cut by half, from 74 million dollars monthly to 37 millions.



Dr. Daniel Patrick Moynihan, one of the world's greatest sociologist, head of the Joint Center of Urban Studies and a specialist on the Negro family, continues expressing his views on issues vital to black Americans in the interview recently granted Muslim Minister Louis Farrakhan of Muhammad's Mosque of Islam No. 7, in New York's Harlem. What the Muslims Want

This is the question asked most frequently by both the whites and the blacks. The answers to this question I shall state as simply

1. We want freedom. We want a full and complete freedom.

2. We want justice. Equal justice under the law. We want justice applied equally to all, regardless of creed or class or color.

3. We want equality of opportunity. We want equal membership in society with the best in civilized expirity.

best in civilized society.

4. We want our people in America whose parents or grandparents were descendants from slaves, to be allowed to establish a sep-arate state or territory of their own—either on this continent or elsewhere. We believe that former slave masters are obligated to provide such land and that the area must be fertile and minerally rich. We believe that our former slave masters are obligated to maintain and supply our needs in this separate territory for the next 20 to 25 years—until we are able to produce and supply our own

Since we cannot get along with them in peace and equality, after giving them 400 years of our sweat and blood and receiving in years of our sweat and blood and receiving in return some of the worst treatment human beings have ever experienced, we believe our contributions to this land and the suffering forced upon us by white America, justifies our demand for complete separation in a state or territory of our own.

5. We want treedom for all Believers of Islam now held in federal prisons. We want freedom for all black men and women now under death sentence in innumerable prisons.

under death sentence in innumerable prisons

in the North as well as the South.

We want every black man and woman to have the freedom to accept or reject being separated from the slave master's children and establish a land of their own.

We know that the above plan for the solu-

We know that the above plan for the solution of the black and white conflict is the best and only answer to the problem between two people.

6. We want an immediate end to the po lice brutality and mob attacks against the so-called Negro throughout the United States.

We believe that the Federal government should intercede to see that black men and women tried in white courts receive justice in accordance with the laws of the land—or allow us to build a new nation for ourselves. dedicated to justice, freedom and liberty.
7. As long as we are not allowed to es

tablish a state or territory of our own, we demand not only equal justice under the laws of the United States, but equal employment opportunities—NOW!

We do not believe that after 400 years of free or nearly free labor, sweat and blood, which has helped America become rich and powerful, that so many thousands of black people should have to subsist on relief, charity or live in poor houses.

8. We want the government of the United States to exempt our people from ALL taxation as long as we are deprived of equal justice under the laws of the land.

9. We want equal education—but separate schools up to 16 for boys and 18 for girls on the condition that the girls be sent to women's colleges and universities. We want all black children educated, taught and trained by their own teachers.

Under such schooling system we believe we will make a better nation of people. The United States government should provide. free, all necessary text books and equipment schools and college buildings. The Muslim teachers shall be left free to teach and train their people in the way of righteousness, de cency and self respect.

10. We believe that intermarriage or race mixing should be prohibited. We want the religion of Islam taught without hinderance or

8. WE BELIEVE in justice for all, whether in God or not; we believe as others, that we are due equal justice as human beings. We believe in equality—as a nation — of equals. We do not believe that we are equal with our slave masters in the status of "freed

We recognize and respect American citi-zens as independent peoples and we respect their laws which govern this nation.

9. WE BELIEVE that the offer of integration is hypocritical and is made by those who are trying to deceive the black peoples into believing that their 400-year-old open enemies of freedom, justice and equality are, all of a sudden, their "friends." Furthermore, we believe that such deception is intended to prevent black people from realizing that the time in history has arrived for the separation from the whites of this nation.

If the white people are truthful about their professed friendship toward the socalled Negro, they can prove it by dividing up America with their slaves.

We do not believe that America will ever be able to furnish enough jobs for her own millions of unemployed, in addition to jobs for the 20,000,000 black people as well.

10. WE BELIEVE that we who declared ourselves to be righteous Muslims, should not participate in wars which take the lives of humans. We do not believe this nation should force us to take part in such wars, for we have nothing to gain from it unless America agrees to give us the necessary territory wherein we may have something to fight for.

11. WE BELIEVE our women should be respected and protected as the women of oth er nationalities are respected and protected.

12. WE BELIEVE that Allah (God) appeared in the Person of Master W. Fard Muhammad, July, 1930; the long-awaited "Messiah" of the Christians and the "Mahdi" of

We believe further and lastly that Allah is God and besides HIM there is no God and He will bring about a universal government of peace wherein we all can live in peace to-

What the Muslims Believe

- 1. WE BELIEVE in the One God Whose proper Name is Allah.
- 2. WE BELIEVE in the Holy Qur-an and in the Scriptures of all the Prophets of God.
- 3. WE BELIEVE in the truth of the Bible, but we believe that it has been tampered with and must be reinterpreted so that mankind will not be snared by the falsehoods that have
- 4. WE BELIEVE in Allah's Prophets and the Scriptures they brought to the people
- 5. WE BELIEVE in the resurrection of the dead—not in physical resurrection—but in mental resurrection. We believe that the so-called Negroes are most in need of mental resurrection; therefore, they will be resurrected first
- Furthermore, we believe we are the peo-ple of God's choice, as it has been written, that God would choose the rejected and the despised. We can find no other persons fitting this description in these last days more than the so-called Negroes in America. We believe in the resurrection of the righteous.
- 6. WE BELIEVE in the judgement; we believe this first judgement will take place as God revealed, in America
- WE BELIEVE this is the time in history for the separation of the so-called Ne tory for the separation of the so-called Ne-groes and the so-called white Americans. We believe the black man should be freed in name as well as in fact. By this we mean that he should be freed from the names imposed upon him by his former slave masters. Names which identified him as being the slave master's slave. We believe that if we are free indeed, we should go in our own peo-le's names, the black peoples of the earth ple's names-the black peoples of the earth
