

# The Teachings Of The Holy Quran

HOLY QURAN Chapter 4:142-

145

THE above verse (142) speaks the truth of the actions of hypocrites. The hypocrite thinks he is deceiving Almighty Allah (God), Himself and those who believe in Allah (God) and who follow His Truth.

AGAIN, the hypocrite is known by his wavering between that (falsehood) and this (truth) and he belongs neither to these nor to those (verse 143).

THIS should make it clear that Allah (God) Shows that type of person His Independence of them by leaving them in such a condition, since they cannot decide between belief in the truth of Allah (God) without adding falsehood to it.

THE hypocrite wants to mix up the truth with falsehood. He sits straddling a fence. He has no sense of loyalty. He will fall on either side, even though it be on the side of the devil. He will fall on the side from which he thinks he can obtain benefit. However, the devil's side will be short-lived.

Verse 144, warns the Muslim, who are true believers, not to take disbelievers for friends, rather than true believers (Muslims). For in taking disbelievers

for friends, Allah (God) will make you manifest and your manifestation will bear you out that you are not a true believer; that you are a hypocrite because your friends are not friends of true believers. Therefore, you are shown up as a hypocrite through your love for disbelievers.

Verse 145 teaches us that "The hypocrites are surely in the lowest depths of the Fire and thou wilt find no helper for them." There are some believers who love the person and the language of the hypocrite and wish to help him. This hurries the believers' own fall. They are against Allah (God) when they try to help a hypocrite.

THERE are many Muslims who try to enlighten the hypocrite. The hypocrite has already proved that he did not want to be enlightened in truth by falling away from it and by taking other than Muslim (believers) for his friend. Being in the lowest depth of fire here, is not referring to literal fire; it is referring to grief. The Holy Quran in other places again teaches you that Allah (God) will give this punishment (grief) to the Original Black People before their being given up to literal fire. The fire of grief is so severe that it is like literal fire to the heart. The disbeliever and hypocrite will live in grief and regret. They will get the fullest punishment for their turning back and for their work against the truth, Allah (God) His Messenger and Islam, and for taking disbelievers and hypocrites for friends. This grief will burn their hearts so

until they will wish that they were dead.

THE Holy Quran Chapter 2, teaches us that when one turns back on his heel and becomes a disbeliever after claiming belief in Allah (God) ... Allah (God) Will Not Guide him but will appoint for the disbeliever and the hypocrite a devil for a guide. Since he would not accept the Right Guidance of Allah (God) then Allah (God) Will Give him what he was seeking, a wrong guide, the devil and he will conduct him to the fire of hell.

IT is easy to tell the hypocrites even in the line of fashion, for they show love for the indecent styles of the devil. There are some Muslims who have fallen low enough to go stepping out half-nude with dresses above their knees, but yet they had claimed Islam. This is a hypocrite.

THE devil put out his evil and filth for us and it is up to us to accept it or reject it. He does not force you to accept it. You, yourself, like it; that is why, regardless to what you claim in belief ... it is what you practice (righteousness) that matters. The Holy Quran is against our claim and practice and work that is other than that of a believer. This singles out many of those once-sisters who claimed belief in Islam.

YOU could not be a Muslim and at the same time be following the devil's way of life. Do not fool yourself. Verse 142 teaches you that you are trying to deceive Allah (God). You cannot deceive the All-Knowing God.

Verse 143 teaches us that the hypocrite wavers between this and that of truth and falsehood. A hypocrite will tell you, "I believe in Allah (God) and I believe in Islam." But he is not willing to follow the Messenger of Allah and Islam, who is his only chance of getting the Love and Guidance of Allah.

THE hypocrite does not see Allah (God) but yet he claims belief in Him, but he is not willing to follow the Messenger of Allah so that he may be guided aright. These are hypocrites who want to believe in part of the truth.

MANY old hypocrites will tell you today, "I believe in Allah (God) and Islam." All Right then, what are you doing out there in the path of hypocrites and disbelievers? Why are you not working and carrying your belief into practice? If his belief is not carried into practice it does not matter what he says. In his heart, he does not believe the Messenger has been given by Allah (God) for his guidance.

THE Bible (1 Jn. 4:20) teaches you that you say that you love the father which is in heaven and whom you have never seen, yet you hate your brother whom you see every day.
