Allah (God) Who came in the person of Master Fard Muhammad, to Whom praises are due forever, has sent the Black man and woman of America a master teacher and leader whose greatest desire is to give life to the mentally dead so-called Negro; that person is the man spoken of in Malachi: 4:5, The Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad. Tuskegee Institute's school of Education bases its teacher training program on the American way of life. Namely, that we are one nation, under God, with liberty and justice for all and that despite the unequal treatment Black teachers and students have been receiving, we as prospective teachers should strive to build the educational

institutions of America and make them superior places of learning.

Therefore the instructor concluded that integration is the long awaited solution to the problem of racism and unequal opportunity for Black youths in America's schools. However, the students in the classroom did not agree with this solution. They made such comments as "Blacks ought to be taught by Blacks" and "what do you tell your students after you have taught them the principles of democracy in an Illinois school system and they go out on the streets of Chicago and find out that Mayor Richard Daley has set up a police state which abuses the rights of others." The instructor could only answer these comments by saying "well this is an American dilemma." If one is truly an educator then the objective is to educate a person under your guidance and give him the necessary knowledge for understanding himself, his environment, and others.

It is my contention that it is the Black educators in America who are the most miseducated people of the nation. They govern their lives on American principles and seek to instill these foreign principles into the minds of school youths knowing that they have never served any beneficial purpose in the past.

THE PRESIDENT of Tuskegee Institute, Dr. Luther H. Foster, said in a recent fall convocation ceremony that "Tuskegee Institute will not participate in any moves toward Black separatism." As he spoke, the large numbers of whites in the audience gave their smiles of approval. This is a disgrace to any Black nation to beg for acceptance into a race of people who have spent two thousand years in caves living the lives of savages while we as black people were building great civilizations that have never been surpassed. So ask yourself again, why does the Black man and woman of America need a friend, a guide, and a teacher? The answer is simple. There is only one man who has the knowledge and know-how for freeing Black people of these arch deceivers and setting up an educational system superior to the white man's grafted system; this man is the only man Allah has given this type of knowledge to, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. All praises are due to Allah for sending us a great leader and teacher.
