As a part of our requirements for teacher certification at Tuskegee Institute, my class in reading instruction for young children was asked to observe young children at work and play at the Russell Nursery School which is operated by Tuskegee Institute. Through a one-way mirror, our instructor asked us to notice the motor skills of the children, the furniture, general makeup of the classroom and the visual aids present. Despite the instructions I had been given, my attention was drawn to the dress of the young original sisters and their teachers, two mini-skirted devils (white women).

SOME of the young Black girls were tumbling on a mat stretched partially across the room while young white boys sat on the floor watching them. These beautiful young sisters were wearing dresses that were too short. When they would form a line and start tumbling across the mat, I could not help but feel embarrassed. Boldly, the two white teachers sat in the children's chairs with their skirts above their knees, smiling and swaying the young Black girls who would climb up on their laps. My instructor kept telling us to look at certain aspects of the room decor, but not once did she

object to the indecency that was evident not did my fellow students even though their facial expressions indicated that they too were ashamed.

I asked my instructor if it was the policy of the nursery school administration to allow teachers to wear mini skirts in the presence of young children? She said she didn't know, but that she would imagine that it was due to individual taste. This situation makes it crystal clear that if a Black Man or Woman is ever to be certified to teach Black children, he or she **MUST** come under the guidance of Allah's (God's) greatest bearer, of truth, the Most Honorable Elijah Muhammad.
