"And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, to gather them together to battle." Rev. 20:8. The Honorable Elijah Muhammad teaches the Black man and woman of America that the white race is nothing but a race of devils; created to break the peace of the Black nation.

THE DEPARTMENT of Behavioral Science conducted its periodic lecture on a topic that may be of interest to the students and faculty groups. On Wednesday, March 19, the chairman of the department lectured on the topic: "What Are Our Students Trying To Tell Us?" The Lecturer stated what he had found out about the attitudes of Tuskegee students, i.e., they were dissatisfied with white instructors and some Black instructors; other students wanted white teachers to become followers rather than leaders in campus departments; still other students desired to have whites remain as instructors on the campus.

As the lecture closed, the floor was given to persons desirous of articulating their views on the topic under discussion. The first person to speak was Dr. Yaura Qualls, a Black director of the Department of Communications who sought to defend white instructors in her department.

"The white instructors in my department teach more "Black Literature" than the Black instructors and sometimes tend to over-teach the Black student. However, Black instructors do not stress such literature. Thus their qualifications are being questioned."

These statements provoked embarrassment and anger from Black teachers present. Immediately, a Black teacher rose from her chair to defend the position of Black teachers and indirectly berated the chairman of the department of communications. Anger had started to pervade the instructors, embarrassed looks discussion. Such a situation as this bears witness to the teach-

ings of The Honorable Elijah Muhammad. Everytime you allow white people to dwell among Black people, there will be conflict.

Here you have Black "Ph.D. holders" debating one another's qualifications in the presence of white people who do not care if they are qualified. I wonder what white instructor conferred with the Black director of the Department of Communications, Dr. Qualls, and convinced her that her colleagues weren't qualified to teach Black students?

WHEN A POINT of order could be established in the discussion, I asked to speak on the matter of white people teaching Black literature: Literature is a product of living communication, and experience. If you have not communicated with Black people on an equal basis for four hundred years, and if you have not experienced the history of the Black man's slave past, which is what so-called Black literature depicts, how can you teach a Black student how to appreciate such literature? Why should one appreciate readings in the brutal and inhuman ways a Black man was socialized to "the American way of life?" Your very nature makes you (white people) the perpetrators of the suffering encompassed in the literature. I told the Black instructors present that when they start questioning their qualifications, are they trying to better their own conditions or appease the arrogant attitudes of the white people in the room? I concluded my remarks by stating the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's teachings on the result of white people intermingling with Blacks; conflict, distrust, hatred. I suggested that they begin questioning the qualifications of the white instructor who told me that "the best way I would feach Black students the meaning of Blackness is to teach them the Black males have a thing about white women."

My statements drew applause from some Black students and
