



Portuguese Officers Attack **Black Airmen**

(Muhammad Speaks New York Bureau)
NEW YORK—According to recent correspondence
received by the American Serviceomer's Union, seven
Black U.S. Air Force members of the Afro-American
Culture Society were attacked by 12 Portuguese officers on May 30 while having a private party at a local
bar outside Lajes Field, Azores, Portugal.

THE 12 PORTUGUESE officers, advised by two white Americans, wielded knives and broken bottles as they attacked the seven Black airmen. The Blacks suffered only minor injuries while seven of the 12 officers required hospital care.

TWO HOURS later a Portuguese colonel arrived at the bar demanding the airmen be banned from the premises. Arriving back at the harracks, the Black airmen were met by Colonel Glassburner, Commander of the 1863 Air Base Group, accompanied by an officer from the U.S. office of Political Relations. They interrogated the men for two hours as four carloads of Air Police watched, and white Navy personnel hurder racial insults and threats. The seven airmen face paying damages they believe they are not responsible for and reassignment back to the United States for further punitive action.

The Afro-American Culture Society says the Black airmen are "in a cross-fire between the Portuguese and American Military establishments. Portugal, at war with three African nations (Angola, Guinea, Mozambique), is clearly a Nazi-white country and flagrantly exhibits this attitude to all Black Americans stationed on her soil. The United States is bending over backwards trying not to offend Portugal because the contract for the military base here is being negotiafed for renewal.

A.S.U. Executive Director Bob Lemay called upon ASU members to "support the right of the Afro-American Culture Society to struggle against Portuguese colonialism." He also condemned "U.S. and NATO compilicity in Portugal's colonial wars in Africa."

Viet Cong For Africa's Freedom Fiaht

PARIS — Despite the fact that more than 40 African countries have gained political independence during the past few decades, "imperialists of all plumage—headed by the United States—have not reconciled themselves to giving up their designs on the wealthy continent, where they still maintain a firm hold on billions of dollars in African resources," states a recent editorial in South Viet Nam: In Struggie, published by the National Front for Liberation (NFL).

"COLONIALISTS are trying every means to replace old-type colonialism by neo-colonialism," the editorial goes on. "Taking advantage of the difficulties that many countries have to confront as the result of the former colonial rule, and using every perfidious maneuver, they set out to preserve their existing interests and wrest new position."

The Viet Cong editors point out that Americans leave no stone unturned to topple governments of independent countries which carry out a policy of active opposition to colonialism or opposition to the continuing plunder of African resources by U.S. and European imperialists.

The Viet Cong paper states that money-and-power-crazed white nations have brought to Africa thousands of secret agents and spiles specialized in sowing division among the people and engineering conflicts and coups d'etats. They have staged armed intervention in the Congo, and come to the rescue of the French and Portuguese colonialists and South African racists for the suppression of the people's movement for independence and freedom.

THE EDITORS point out that Vietnamese resistance

THE EDITORS point out that Vietnamese resistance to U.S. aggression, under the leadership of the NFL, has always enjoyed the deep sympathy and unreserved support of the peoples and many governments of Africa.

"Recently, African leaders, governments and mass organizations have warmly welcomed and strongly backed the NFL overall solution to the South Vietnamese problem to help restore peace in Viet Nam." the editors continue. "This forms a new, very valuable expression of Africa's militant solidarity with our people."

The editorial asserts that the National Front for Liberation and all the patriotic people of South Viet Nam highly rate and attach great importance to Africa's support.

"On our part," they continue, "as in the past, we continue to shore up the just liberation struggle of the fraternal peoples of Africa against imperialism and colonialism of the old and new patterns.

"AT THE FOREFRONT of the fight against American imperialism here in Southeast Asia, the South Vietnamese people share the difficulties and hardships of the African peoples and, together with them and other non-white peoples around the world, are doing their best to make an active contribution to the common fight against the U.S. scheme of aggression, domination and spoliation

Saga of Black GI's Exile to Flee Unjust War

(Pan African Press)

**STOCKHOLM, Sweden—"More than 75 Black U.S. soldiers are in exile here after deserting the Army in protest against its white supremacy policies and against America's barbaric slaughter in Viet Nam." said Donald Williams, a Black soldier who fled to Stockholm from Fort Benning, Ga., to escape shipment to Viet Nam."

WILLIAMS POINTED OUT in an interview with MUHAMMAD SPEAKS that altogether some 500 U.S. soldiers are in exile here rather than "dance to the music of America's fascis political rulers."

The young ex-sergeant spent three months in Sweden as co-chairman of the Afro-American Deserters Committee. His main duty was to help find living quarters and jobs for U.S. servicemen who had descrited.

"I only stayed three months," he said, "because even though I knew I faced certain court martial in America, I felt I could do more back in the States to help awaken Black people and fight the U.S. power structure." Williams admitted, however, that what he eventually faced in America as worse than anything he had expected.

Explaining how he managed to go to Stockholm while still in the Army, Williams said he made up his mind to leave while stationed at Ft. Benning, Ga., when his unit was alerted in June 1987 for duty in Viet Nam.

Nam.
"I tried to get out of the unit then because I couldn't see fighting in Viet Nam for a so-called freedom that I didn't have in my own home town," the Chicago exsoldier said.

soldier said.

IN JANUARY of 1988, he was transferred to Martin Army Hospital in Ft. Benning, because he had made his views on Viet Nam known and it was thought by Army brass to be in "the best interests of his unit" that he be sent somewhere else.

"At this point I decided not to become a U.S. tool in the race-politics in Asia," Williams said. He and his family made plans for escape.

Williams changed his Army records to indicate that his wife and two daughters were living in Chicago, and not in Jackson, Miss., where they actually would be in hiding, with the help of friends.

He set the wheels into motion to leave the States by first forging papers that would give him permission to take a 30-day leave with military transportation to Germany.

to take a 30-day leave with military transportation to ferrmany.

"With my phony orders, I went to Dover Air Force Base in Delaware and caught a military hop to Ger-many. I had been in the Army seven years at that time, and I knew the workings of the Army red tape. I just used that knowledge.

"When I got to Frankfort, Germany, I went to the railroad station and bought a ticket for Stockholm, avoiding the airport for obvious reasons.

"AT CENTRAL Station here, I walked up to the first policeman I saw and told him I was a resister against the U.S. Army and that I was seeking political asylum against the racist system in the United States."

Williams explained to the policeman, and later to other Swedish officials that he was not just dissenting against the war in Viet Nam but against the whole exploitative system inside and outside—controlled by white America.

"The police took me into custody for 24 hours until they could contact the lawyer handling our cases and get the necessary papers filled out. It was a formality only, but it kind of shook me up," he said.

Williams met several young Swedish "intellectuals," students and "everyday working people," and he said they all sympathized with his plight.

"They, started a fund raising campaign to bring my wife and children here," he related. "They raised more than \$800 and I was able to send my family tickets. When they arrived, I felt it was the happiest moment of my life."

After three months in Stockholm, Williams brought his family back to America.

"I WAS ARRESTED and thrown into the Fort Dix stockade as soon as I set foot on American soil," he releated. "I was put into a barracks with other 'political prisoners." The treatment was brutal; everything was directed against us. We were forced to fall out in the rain at three in the morning, subjected to beatings and contrived torture, forbidden to write or receive letters, and our families could not visit us."

Williams said he finally smuggled a letter to the American Civil Liberties Union out through a prisoner who was being released. The ACL assigned Atty. Michael Kennedy to Williams' case. The lawyer called a press conference and revealed the barbaric treatment suffered by political prisoners at Ft. Dix. "When they decide you are a disciplinary case," Williams began, "they particularly place you in isolation—the box."

"When they decide you are a disciplinary case," Williams they are wooden bench, and you were required to sit up all day. The only food consisted of three meals of lettuce and water—nothing else.

"They can keep you in the box for 14 days, then must let you out for one day. Then they can put you back in for another 14 days.

"As soon as I got to Ft. Riley. I began organizing—whites, Blacks, anyone who would listen to the truth about this country and what America is doing in Viet

Nam," the Black soldier said. "Right away they tried to get rid of me. The Post Commander, Gen. Collins, tried to get me shipped to the Disciplinary Barracks at Leavenworth, Kansas. But prisoners must have at least a one year term to be sent there, so they had to keep me—for a while, anyway.

Williams had completed his six month sentence. He
received an "Undesirable Discharge," and is now living in Chicago.

"The discharge is a source of pride and honor to

system in America. The discharge is proof that I'm





We suffer with many aliments in our bodies due to the fact that we are pourring into if food that should not be put in that body (which is the fineet nature-built machinery on Earth), and due to the fact that we are not waiting until the strength or power of the poison in the previous meal becomes weak, so that it will be harmless when the strength of a new meal is added. But, twenty-four (24) to forty-eight (48) hours will destroy the poison from the previous meal, Allah (God) Taught me; then fill up and go until this is exhausted, and then eat another meal. It is logical. As I keep repeating, we dig our own graves, and I may add here that we bring about our won death with our teeth.

So, this is the way Allah (God) has taught me; to heal our sickness and prolong our lives with one meal a day. And, whenever those of you who work in offices and do light work are able, you can eat one meal every fourty-eight (48) hours; which would give you more days to your life. That is true, but if you want to add a few more days to this aiready distant age you have, you can add to your life by stopping right now from plunging into the grave, and you could add more days to your life.




