## Aid U.S. Image Abroad

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla.—Mrs. Rosa Page Welch, singer, teacher and humanitarian, who recently returned from two years as a missionary in Nigeria, told an audience at Gibbs Junior College here that fellow Americans ought to help improve the nation's image abroad through service and goodwill efforts in foreign countries.

## Georgia Rights Fighter May Lose Marine Corps Job

ATLANTA, Ga.—The President's Committee on Equal Employment Opportunity was urged to investigate the case of an Albany (Ga.) minister and active rights fighter who faces the loss of his job at the Albany Marine Corps Supply Center because of his conviction—which has been appealed—by a Federal jury.

In its letter to Executive Director John Field of the equal job committee, the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee called for a "complete investigation of Rev. Samuel Wells' case."

This message followed closely on the heels of protests wired to the commandant of the supply center, Lieut. Gen. Wallace M. Greene, Jr. and Secretary of Defense Robert S. McNamara. Secretary McNamara was asked to do "everything in your power to insure that Reverend Wells is not being fired because of his participation in the civil rights movement."

Reverend Wells, pastor of the Blue Springs Baptist and William Springs Baptist Churches, and a sandblaster at the Marine Supply Center

in Albany, has been notified that he is to be removed from his job because of "conduct unbecoming a Federal employee."

General Greene told SNCC here in a letter that "Mr. Wells is receiving fair and just treatment."

Wells, along with Mrs. Elza Jackson, recording secretary of the Albany Movement, and seven other Albany civil rights leaders were indicted and convicted by Federal juries on "perjury" and "conspiracy" charges.

Reverend Wells and the others were accused of falsely telling a Federal grand jury they were not present

or could not remember being present at a meeting where a boycott of a white Albany merchant was discussed.

The minister was sentenced to a year and a day in jail. Mrs. Jackson was sentenced to three years on probation.

All convictions have been appealed.

## Nyasaland Women Rush to Register At Polls

ZOMBA, Nyasaland—Statistics released by the Elections' Office here recently disclosed that 1,871,170 persons registered to vote in Nyasaland during the recent registration period.

Some 55 per cent of the number, 1,056,969 were women. Six hundred are Europeans.

## Only 1 Out of 300

ATLANTA — The lack of educational opportunities for Negroes has led to America being deprived of top flight engineers at a time when engineers are in high demand.

A. W. Lindert, director of government contracts for American Oil Company, gave as an example the fact that among engineers only one-third of one per cent are Negroes, or one out of 300.

He said the ratio should be about one out of 10.

## 'White' Tuskegee High

TUSKEGEE, Ala. — Once all-white Tuskegee High School, one of several Alabama schools from which Gov. George Wallace tried to bar Negro students and which has been boycotted by KKK-type whites since a Federal Court ordered it desegregated, has been dropped from the accredited list of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

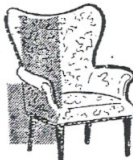
