The riot commission report. without doubt, also bristles with a certain amount of urgency. It calls for mammoth, multi-billion dollar reforms ranging from measures to create two million new jobs to provisions for a guaranteed minimum wage and enactment of open housing legislation.

HOWEVER, coming out as it does in an election year, the study is bound to become an expedient political football.
