CHICAGO — The noble stature and virtuous path carved out for the Muslim woman by this meek and majestic lady — as she gave beacon light and graceful examples to the mighty directives of Messenger Muhammad — as she sought the restoration of the Black woman as Queen of the Universe cannot be reduced and measured, either by sentence, or Death.

AS THE TENDERLY beloved help - meet of Muhammad for 55 years, Sister Clara Muhammad — in her deeply moving, quiet way — set a sterling, ringing national

standard for all Black women to follow. She never trembled before the blazing odds, which saw her courageous husband herded into jail

Nation of Islam: progress certain

Progress:
2a. Advance or movement to an objective or towards a goal: purposeful getting or going ahead. (Webster's 3rd New International Dictionary; un-abbreviated)

In part I of this study an understanding of progress was decided upon as a useful parameter by which we might be able to judge the qualities of any people, leader or Nation.

Against this background we have broken down the definition of progress, as defined above, into four categories: social, political, economic and religious. Part I discussed Social and Political Progress. Let's go on with the last two categories.

One has to really search hard to find any real evidence of economic progress amongst Black people other than the Muslims, because it is only amongst the Muslims as a whole that it exists. Certainly there are some very well - do Black people in America but I don't think you are going to find any amongst the super rich.

No argument that a handful of Black businesses are starting to establish a solid foundation, but brother, we're 30 million strong and spend 30 billion dollars a year!

The gaping holes in the government's so-called Black Capitalism are there for all to see, and no one seems ready to argue against the obvious fact that such a program has been a failure and the overall economic progress of the Blackman here in America has not appreciably changed in many a moon.

We have been out of physical slavery for over 100 years, yet who is still the last hired and the first fired? A recession for the whiteman is a whopping depression for the Black.

Yet under the umbrella of Islam and the guidance of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the Muslims can boast of the most forceful economic progress imaginable.

I'm not talking about barbershops, beauty parlors and greasy spoon restaurants, I'm talking about the basics so vitally necessary for the growth, PROGRESS and development of any nation of civilized people - food, shelter and clothing.

I won't go any further here

since in every issue of this dynamic newspaper as well as the fact of the newspaper itself, the reality of the ECONOMIC PROGRESS of the Nation of Islam is abundantly illustrated, in black and white.

Even outside sources in a recent study evaluated the economic worth of the Nation of Islam at approximately \$75 million and that did not account for those things the Honorable Elijah Muhammad already has on the drawing board.

Now, how about RELIGIOUS PROGRESS? Pardon me while I laugh. Is there anyone of you, after really taking a close look at the Christian religion, that has been given to us by the slavemaster, that can really talk about religious progress?

The only progress we have made religiously under the whiteman is a backward one, if I may use such a contradiction of terms. To give up one's own God for that of the enemy and slavemasters' certainly must be classified as ludicrous.

To roll up and down the aisle as a Holy Roller "In" or "Out" of Christ calling upon a Mystery God that doesn't even exist certainly borders on the psychotic.

Please understand, I am not making mockery of anyone, for the Honorable Elijah Muhammad has shown us that we all have come from that kind of life, but once we have learned to step back and see the situation clearly it appears truly ridiculous.

However, when we realize that we have been robbed of a knowledge of ourselves and God, the situation becomes more understandable, but certainly not more acceptable.

Now, however, when a clear argument comes, when a bright light shines forth to dispell darkness and we clearly find that which has been spawned by darkness has no foothold or place in the universal order of things, it is nothing but foolhardy to run back into the darkness.

The Honorable Elijah Muhammad has come from the very mouth of God and has given to us another religion, for one of his most lucid articles irrevocably dispelled the notion that Islam is a religion, but is instead the more certain, more satisfying, more understandable nature in which the Blackman was created and is his natural way of life.

Thus when we accept Islam as taught by the Honorable Elijah Muhammad religious progress is assured.

This entire subject of "progress" under the leadership of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad is an exciting one indeed. No doubt books could be written about it, as this newspaper certainly attests to.
