He enumerated the similarities of the two faiths ranging from the belief in One God to the honor of religious heroes.

Muslims and Jews "have One God, one religious spirit," he said. Further the "source of revelation" is the same. "We should want to come together to defend the life we all cherish."

Continuing, Emam Muhammad said, "Again God tells us in the Quran that the Muslims will find the food of the Jews acceptable to them, and your food acceptable to the Jews."

**MUTUAL RESPECT**

Pointing out that Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) taught respect for the places of worship, Emam Muhammad said that the Muslims are obligated "not only

to respect the Houses of Worship of the Muslims but they are obligated also to respect the Houses of Worship of the Jews and Christians."

Repeating his appeal for closer cooperation, Emam Muhammad said that he was "anxious" to see the Muslims and Jews come closer together "so that we can fight together the evils that are plaguing

**A MORAL NEED**

In this light, he declared that he would like to see Muslims, Christians and Jews come together to discuss common problems "and try to bring about a healthy patriotism in the country and to protect America so that the morals will grow stronger."

Emam Muhammad said he was certain that the Jews recognized the problems of religion for the American people. The Muslims, he said, also have a great understanding of these problems. Together Muslims and Jews "can help Christian leadership to inspire the Christian community and bring many lost souls back to the worship of One God, and respect for true religion."

"I believe," he said, (that with the cooperation of Muslims, Christians and Jews,) "we can make it possible for many Americans, who have turned their backs on God, turned their backs on religion, to come back to God, and to come back to religion." Concluding, Emam Muhammad reminded the audience that "We are one fellowship—brothers and sisters under God."
