

Boston University of Islam Inspired By Messenger Muhammad

 BOSTON—An outstanding example of the fruits of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's emphasis on the importance of education among black people, is this city's University of Islam and the impact it has made on Boston's citizenry.

STILL IN ITS fledgling stages, the school has grown from an enrollment of about 90 students at its opening in April to a present student body of 126. Already plans are being made for an expected expansion.

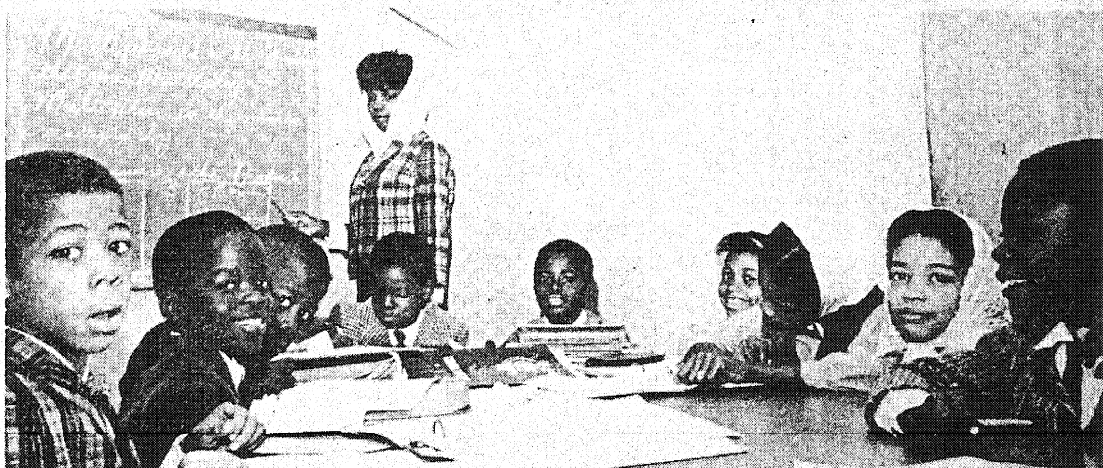
Courses range from mathematics, science subjects and spelling to an Original History course which is currently providing insights on the life of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad from the time of his birth to the present magnitude of the Nation of Islam.

Principal is Sister Shirley 2X, a dedicated educator whose program is winning the applause of the entire black Massachusetts community. Aiding her in her battle to bring better education to black children is Minister Don, of Muhammad's Boston Mosque No. 11.

STAFF INCLUDES nine regular teachers and six substitutes at this point. These teachers each provide instruction in specialized fields.

The university is located in a three-story building, a former family dwelling. The building houses 13 rooms which were converted into classrooms. It underwent complete renovation for use as a school facility.

The school is now completely temperature-controlled with heated air for winter and cool air for summer. At present, it is a Saturday school but officials are looking toward the not-too-far-off day when it will be a full time facility.

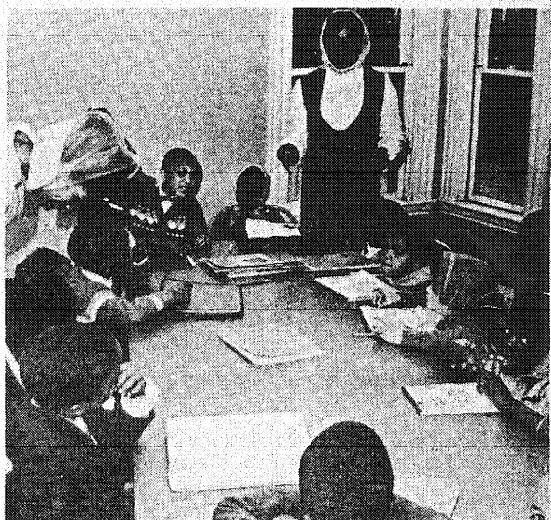


FOURTH GRADE MATH instructor Sister Pamela conducts lessons on nuances of multiplier and product at Boston Uni-
