the mind that you understand in Al-Islam. You keep your good Muslim behavior.

Don't you get excited and picket his meetings or try to challenge him in public. No! No one should say anything against him.

If that's the proper thing to do, you should bring it to me and I will look at it. If I think it's the proper thing, too, I'll say okay, let's challenge him in the public. But, if you challenge him, you hurt me. Don't challenge him. Don't criticize him. Don't do anything except pray for Allah's guidance and mercy.

If you want to criticize him at home or to yourself, that's different. But, don't go out into the public. Don't make this a public thing.

Don't go to his public meetings. I'm not afraid that if you go to his public meetings you'll be converted. But I'm afraid that if you go the enemy of you, me and Al-Islam will start trouble and blame it on you.

They will say, "Some of the members of the World Community of Al-Islam came here and tore up the meeting. They disrupted the meeting, (Farrakhan's meeting). They behaved like a bunch of savages. They're wild, vicious, violent, fanatical people." They want to do this. Don't you know Minister Farrakhan is of hardly any importance to the American people.

Who is it now that's so anxious to make Minister Farrakhan a great public figure and challenge to the WCIIW? Who is anxious to do this? It's the people who want to destroy us, not Farrakhan.

They don't want to hurt Farrakhan. If they wanted to hurt Farrakhan they would just ignore him.

Minister Farrakhan is not going to change the world of the racists and the separatists. Minister Farrakhan is not going to make it possible for African-Americans to get as much opportunity in

the city, state, government, and the world as that individual deserves.

Minister Farrakhan, by the very nature of his program is going to effect a withdrawal from opportunities. Why? Because as soon as Minister Farrakhan gets branded as a Black Supremacist, as a Black Nationalist, right away his immediate followers and all those influenced by him will be ostracized.

Their narrow philosophy gives racists an excuse. They say, "These people are not Americans, they are un-American. They are not people who uphold the democratic processes of this country. They are not people who believe in the humanitarian ideas that we believe in. So what right have we to invite them to equal opportunity or into our circles?"

No, they shut themselves out by their own philosophy, and the racists know and encourage it.

Minister Farrakhan wants economic success. He wants business growth. He wants the development of the African communities and the African-American communities. I want the same, but I want it with Al-Islam. If any of you talk to him, I hope you will go back and tell him. This is a challenge I'm making to him right now. I'm challenging him to produce more business with his philosophy than I produce with Al-Islam, with the Holy Quran.

This leadership is going to provide more jobs; this leadership is going to have more business; this leadership is going to have more human dignity at home and abroad. That's my challenge.

This is not a challenge to him as my enemy. This is my challenge to him as my friend. I want to show my friend that I have a better way than he has. Now here's my word to my enemy and Farrakhan's enemy:

"You bastard! You'll never pull me out in the street to do one ounce of harm to Minister Farrakhan! You go to hell, you bastard!"
