

# You Have Been Whipping Boy For White Man

I am grateful for the opportunity of expressing my views about the Negro in this space. Coming from a white man, my opinions will probably be resented, misunderstood and ignored. My hope is that they will be discussed.

The Negro is getting the business . . . no question about it. You have been the whipping boy for the white man for centuries. Your lot, however, is improving. You are being helped the most by the law . . . you are being legislated into a few more benefits . . . your rights are little by little being recognized. In other words your opponents are giving in, their opposition is being whittled away - the Negro is getting help. Unfortunately, you are not helping yourself as much as you should and today your real enemy actual or visual is yourself.

### Self-Pity

The negroes in America are drowning themselves in self-pity. They are so discrimination-conscious that they have put the right to ride on a bus as their number one goal. This to me is "Hog Wash." You will ride eventually and eat in all restaurants and stay in any hotel of your choosing . . . So What! What are you doing about training your children to earn enough to ride any bus or to eat in any restaurant or stay in any hotel. The Negro, unlike his predecessors the immigrants, has failed to employ the one weapon which guarantees equality. It did not take the immigrant Irish, Pole, Italian or Jew long to realize the rules of the game and how to prosper under them.

### Down Trodden

This country despite its obvious virtue is ruled by the dollar. The smarter the man or woman the more money he makes. The smarter the man or woman is the more capable he is of forwarding his own ambitions and that of his race. Brains are the commodity that the Negro has failed to make his main objective. It would seem that the Negro prefers to enjoy the down trodden role, prefers to be kicked around and is happy to complain about mistreatment. The answer to the Negroes problem is so simple that it frightens me.

### Force Education

Every mother, father or do gooder should take the Negro child at age three and force education down that child's throat, as you do their morning cereal. Every Negro child should be forced and whipped into studying and getting excellent grades in school. The Negro boys and girls should win the spelling bees and school prizes for excellence in scholarship. They should win every job that is based upon a competitive written exam . . . This is the goal, this is the only when he fills the mind of his child with stories of racial hate and strife. Remember that today's Negro child is brand new . . . don't damn him with self-pity, which only ends up with his saying "The hell with it."

### Treated Badly

Negro parents, no question about it, have had a tough row to hoe. They have been treated badly, but that is part of yesterday's story. The future is in the

hands of the children. Does the Negro want his child to compete against my child who has been forged to study night after night as compared to the Negro child who has been skipping school and hanging out on the street corner. What chance has the Negro kid got. . . I tell you - none.

### Long Hours

The question may arise who am I to say. Well, I came from a very poor neighborhood in the city of Boston where most of the

residents of the neighborhood either spoke no english or spoke very poor english. None of them ever read a good book or saw a good play or the inside of a library. They worked long-hours for little money and were dis-

criminated against in a thousand different ways. What did they do for their children? I will tell you . . . they broke their little fannies if they did not go to school and get good marks. They deprived themselves of such luxuries as coal, food and transportation, so that these kids could go to college. It paid off . . . It will pay off for the Negro too. Brains are always in demand . . . every employer wants to hire brains and the best of them. The best are

always in demand, no matter what their race or creed. In this country only the poor are kicked around. So Negroes get with it, in sports you have shown your ability, now do it in the classroom and it will not be long before you will not have to worry about being able to ride in a bus . . . eat in a restaurant or stay in a hotel for you will own it and when you do . . . Please treat us better than we treated you.
