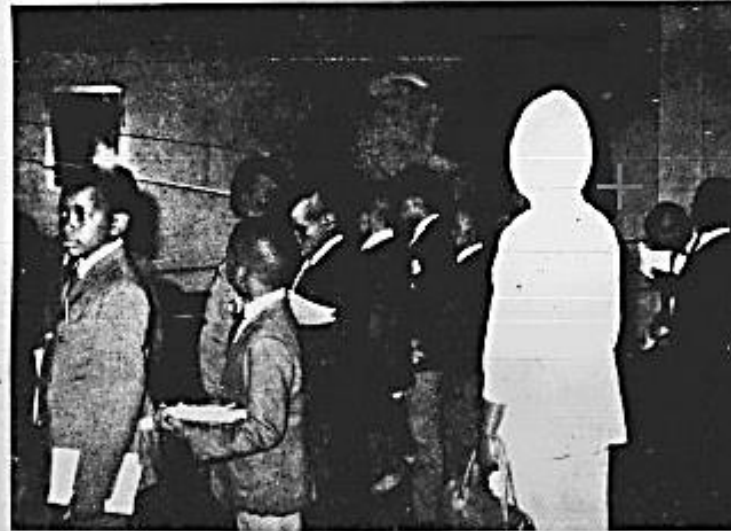
areas to the furthering of her Holy Black Nation, with the Divine Teachings of MESSENGER MUHAMMAD.
