In this condition, the crumb of the bread stretches before breaking when milled. before breaking when pulled, which is the normal moist elas-tic quality of new bread. When chewed hurriedly, and most peo-ple eat in this manner, the bread forms little solid lumps mixed with saliva and stomach gastric juices. This is considered the most indigestible of food.

A steady diet of this gooey, hard-to-chew mass coagulates along the alimentary canal. This could cause constipation and its many ills."
