Humphrey Sees Uneasy Negro Job Future

WASHINGTON — Negroes can look forward to a future which holds even greater economic crisis, with the gap widening between their training and job requirements, according to Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey.

Humphrey told the White House Conference on Equal Employment Opportunity that nonwhite joblessness increased in July when the national unemployment rate fell to 4.5 per cent.

"THREE NEGRO MEN in five are unskilled or semi-skilled. And more than half the Negro men over 25 have been provided with less than a grammar school education," Humphrey said.

"In Northern industrial center's, one out of every three Negro workers has suffered unemployment in the past few years. In some neighborhoods, the unemployment rate among Negroes is as high as 40 per cent."

Humphrey said that nothing is more important to the Negro in his struggle to free himself from his circle of frustration than the ability to hold a good job.

"PROBLEMS OF SPIRIT are intimately tied to more and better job opportunities," he said. "We must understand that generations of prejudice, deprivation, and subservience have produced profound despair."

apathy and mistrust. "What can we expect when hope is resolutely crushed from the young, when there are no jobs even for the educated, and no homes in good neighborhoods even for the hard-working?"

"WE MUST CREATE a climate of equal rights and equal respect which encourages the exercise of man's unique capacities; the potentiality for creativity and the motivation toward excellence," he said.

Household Hints

An easy made funnel for filling salt and pepper shakers can be made by using the corner of an envelope and cutting off a small portion of the tip.

Onions will not make the eyes water if scalding water is poured over them before they are peeled.

Never put cold water in a hot utensil, until utensil has cooled to room temperature. Sudden changes in temperature may cause the metal to warp—resulting in uneven bottoms.

A common clothespin, split in half makes two ideal and economical pan scrapers which do not rust or scratch enamelware or precious aluminum.

If you have trouble opening a jar of home canned fruit try this: Turn the jar upside down in hot water deep enough to cover the lid. Let it stand for a few minutes then unscrew it as usual.

Wax the rockers and legs of your chairs. They will not mar the waxed floor when moved about.

Pour boiling water on oranges and let stand for five minutes. This will make the white lining come away from the skin and they will be easier to prepare.

When painting, fasten cotton batting to wrists with rubber bands to keep paint from running down the arm.
