Secret Police Document Says --

You're A Muslim If You're Well-Dressed, Clean-Cut

SAN DIEGO Calif.—A highly secret genocide-provoking pamphlet designed to instill prejudice among the nation's policemen against Black Muslims, was exposed when honest citizens turned the documents over to MUHAMMAD SPEAKS.

Reprinted from the San Diego Academy Training Bulletin, the eight-page mimeographed anti-Muslim story now being circulated was found to be filled with misinformation and outright lies.

In many ways ridiculous, however, it often pays unwitting compliments to the followers of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad as when it remarks upon

the "intelligence" of Muslim members and states that "the most likely" Negroes to be members are "the clean cut... well-dressed and groomed."

Solid proof of its attempt to provoke police attacks upon peace-loving Muslims however, is contained in its instruction to policemen to request "back-up" patrols on any incident involving a possible Muslim "regardless of how trivial the incident," and to report on "possible" Muslims.

One section entitled "POLICE TARGET" states:

"The nucleus of the Nation of Islam is comprised of 20 to 30

year old men called, "The Fruit of Islam." These men are selected for their physical prowess and are adept for their aggressive tactics and judo. They are almost psychotic in their dedication and hatred of Caucasians and are comparable to the Mau Mau or Kamikaze in their dedication and fanaticism. It has been reported that many temples have gun clubs in which this militant group is trained in weapons."

It failed to point out that Muslims do not carry weapons and that unarmed Muslims were shot down in cold blood by armed Los Angeles police on the night of April 27, 1962.

The MUSLIMS in the Los Angeles area, like their cult elsewhere, are highly disciplined. The "clean cut" Negro, well-dressed and groomed, is the most likely member of the organization; male members of the inner circle wear dark suits, white shirts and maroon ties. Many are well-educated and all are well trained.

Officers should, however, be apprehensive and alert to any eminent threat to these fanatics. Patrol Officers should request a "back-up" on any investigation or police incident involving a possible MUSLIM, regardless of how trivial the incident.

Officers are directed to make a report on any incident involving a possible MUSLIM. As a police officer you are confronted with many hazards and dangers; however, it should be stressed that any contact with the MUSLIM cult should be with alertness and caution.

I have just heard the word that Paul Robeson, the singer who made Mississippi ("That Ole Man River") famous, may soon be named Professor of Music at a University in Ghana.

He sure just keeps rolling along!

Tanganyika, the East African nation whose first Prime Minister, Mr. Julius Nyerere, recently resigned in favor of a Muslim colleague, the Honorable Rashidi Kawawa, may soon become a Republic.

If so, Mr. Nyerere is certain to become the country's first President.

A nineteenth-century wood carving of a head from the Republic of Gabon, on the West Coast of Africa, now on display at the Museum of Primitive Art in New York City, has been acclaimed by the connoisseurs of African art in this country as a "truly great masterpiece."

The Afro-Asian bloc in the United Nations is now fifty-one-strong, giving the non-white world a permanent edge over Europe and America in terms of General Assembly votes. And two or three new votes will further add to the bloc's power, later this year, when Algeria, Uganda and possibly Ruanda-Urudi (all in Africa) attain their independence and join the United Nations.

The government of South Africa has announced a plan under which it would "provide every possible assistance" to white settlers in Kenya who may wish to leave that country, when it becomes independent, and re-settle in South Africa. The question is: Where would the white settlers go when South Africa itself goes the way of Kenya and other independent African states, as it inevitably must?

The "Voice of America" hopes to increase its broadcasts beamed to Africa in the very near future. The Government agency may use, for this purpose, the powerful short-wave transmitters now being set up in — you guessed it! — Greenville, N.C. (in the South).

It will be our pleasure to see once again, in September of this year, our good and respected friend, Mr. Hocine Ait-Achmad, one of the five Algerian nationalist leaders recently liberated from a jail in Paris. He is expected to visit the United States at that time in connection with the next session of the United Nations General Assembly.

Important African leaders who recently paid the USA an official visit included President Ahmadou Ahidjo of the Federal Republic of Cameroun and the Honorable Sylvanus Olympio, President of the Republic of Togo.

A "big change" is taking place in the entire continent of Africa. The news of a "big change" (for the better, of course) in the United Arab Republic is particularly pleasing: Egypt is eliminating all foreign street names still in existence in Alexandria, Cairo and other major cities of the country. The main thoroughfare in Alexandria, for instance, has for scores of years been known as "Rue Rosette." Its new (Arabic) name: Sharia al-Horria ("Liberation Street.")

The man who served seven years in jail as the "convicted leader" of the anti-British Mau Mau "terrorism," Jomo Kenyatta, has just been named the first African Minister of State in the newly-formed government of his beloved country, Kenya.

Tom Mboya, another well-known African nationalist leader, has been given the post of Minister of Labor.
